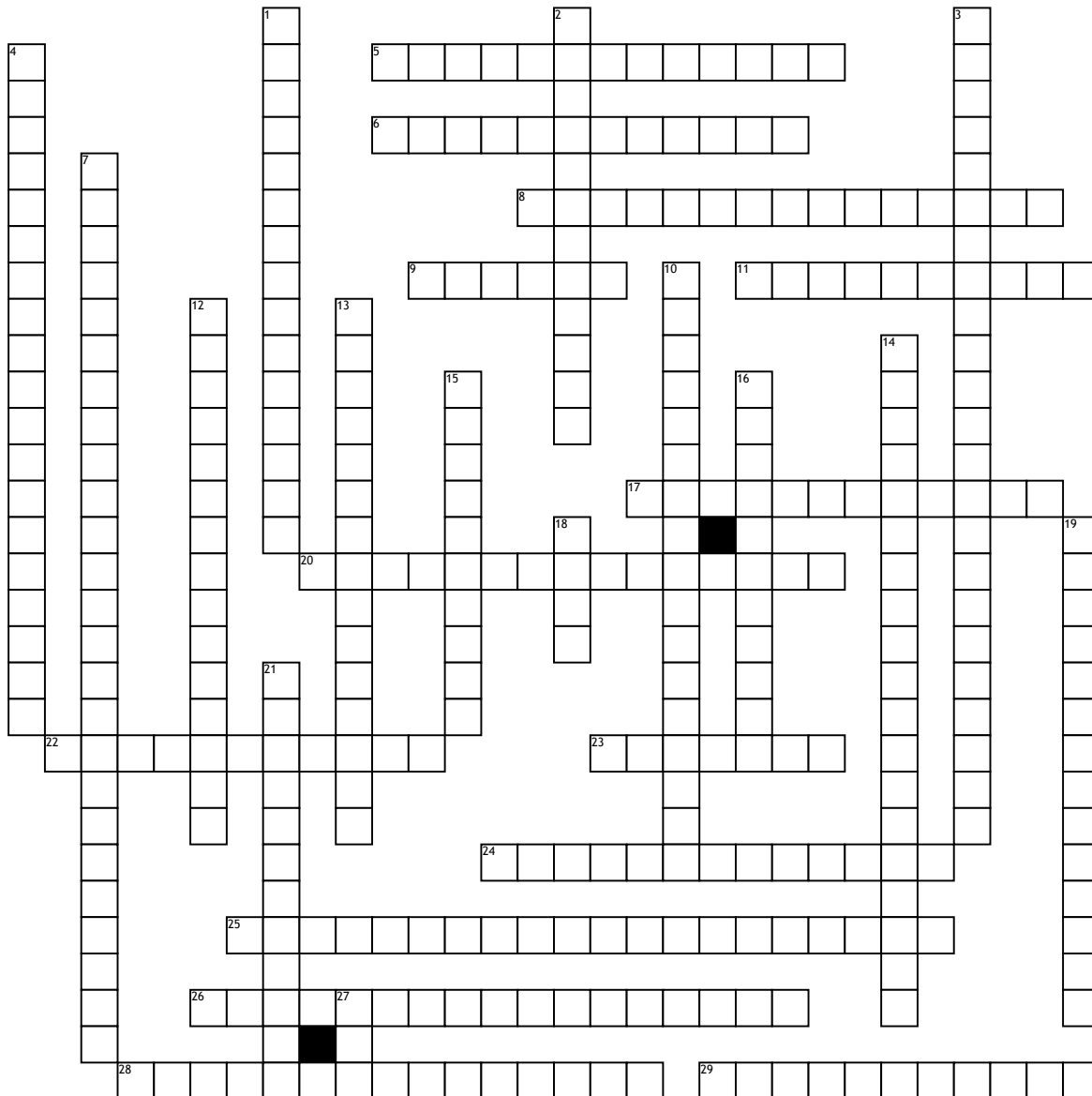

 6. Wires are used to reduce fractures of the wrist bones of the hands and feet are also used for skeletal traction
 8. Procedure in which bone fragments are reduced manually without surgical intervention
 9. The use of radioactive cesium in the treatment of certain illnesses including prostate cancer
 11. Endoscope used for examination of the urinary bladder
 17. Creation of an artificial joint to correct ankylosis
 20. The removal of bony fragments or disc material that may be causing neural impingement
 22. Crushing of calcification in the renal pelvis, ureter, or urinary bladder by mechanical force or sound waves
 23. A state of sterility condition; in which living pathogens are absent
 24. Narrow screw for cortical bone

25. The internal fixator will be introduced from the distal aspect of a long bone
 26. When a special external fixator is used to lengthen long bones as a treatment for severe fracture or congenital deformity
 28. Fixes porous and spongy bone
 29. Disease of a joint

1. Large screw used for internal fixation of non-displaced fracture of proximal femur
 2. a procedure that uses rods, plates, and screws to stabilize surgically altered vertebrae
 3. Screw and plate combination used to apply forces through the fracture site; used commonly for a long bone shaft fractures or stress may be great
 4. The nail or Rod will be inserted from the proximal end of the long bone
 7. Cage filled with bone and inserted between the vertebral bodies to maintain disc space height and permit Fusion of the intervertebral joint

10. type of proximal femur fracture, fracture extends along the

12. Gallbladder removal
 13. Demonstrates anatomy of the biliary ductal system, drainage into the duodenum, and any residual stones in the biliary system
 14. a surgical procedure to repair the hip partly or fully replacing the hip joint with prosthetic substitutes
 15. Surgical opening into one or more lamina of the vertebral Arch
 16. Stiffening of a joint by operative means
 18. Electro-hydraulic shock wave used to break apart calcifications in the urinary system
 19. a spinal condition primarily affecting older patients; caused by degenerative changes that result in enlargement of the facet joints
 21. Orthopedic wire that tightens around the fracture site to reduce shortening of the limb
 27. Anterior cruciate ligament
