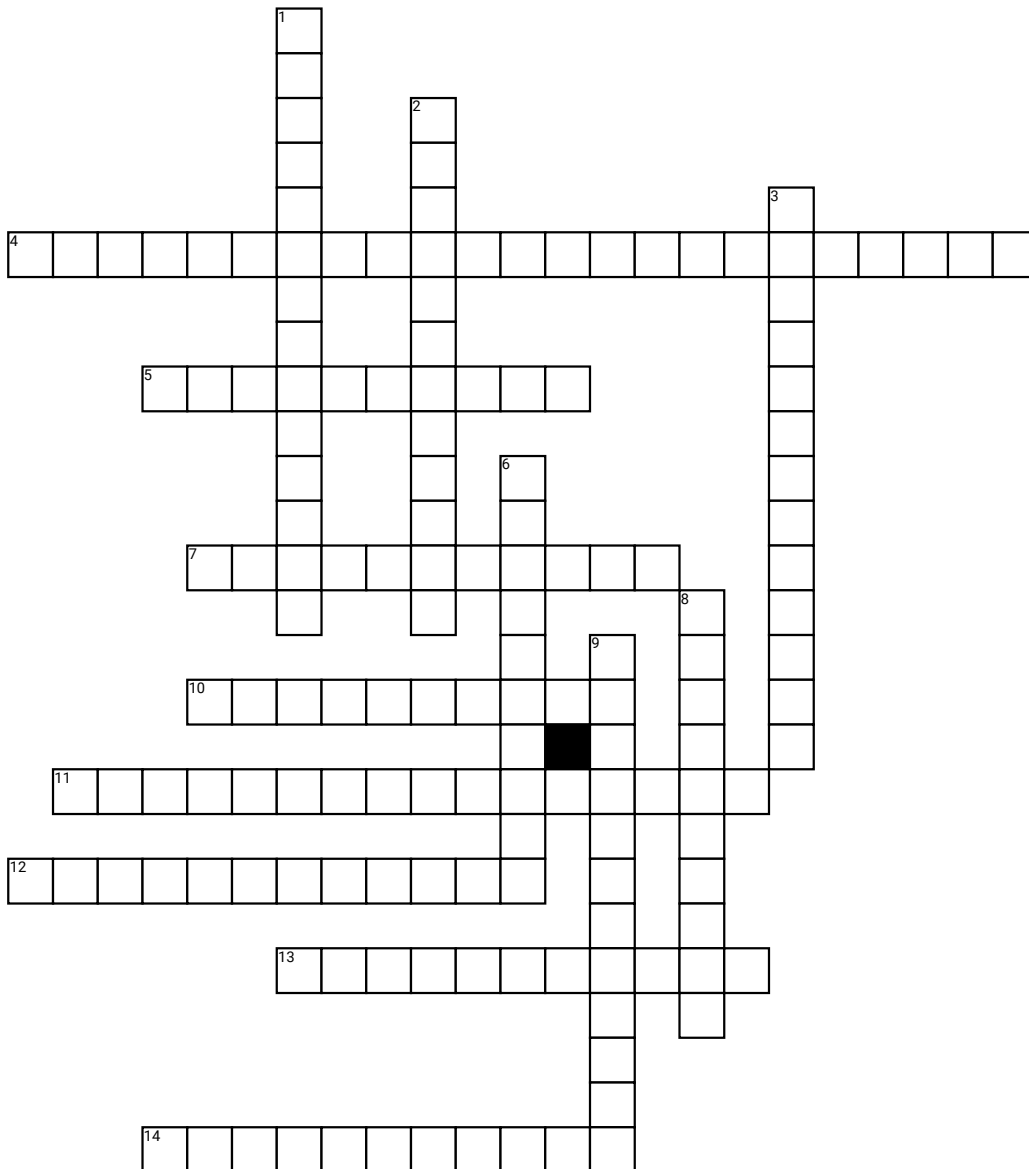

- 4. Often referred to as the Whipple procedure, is the most common operation to treat pancreatic cancer in which the head of the pancreas, the duodenum, and a portion of the stomach, as well as the gallbladder and a portion of the bile duct is removed
- 5. Procedure to examine the cervix, vagina, and vulva for signs of disease
- 7. A minimally invasive surgical procedure on a joint
- 10. Surgical removal of one or both breasts, partially or completely

- 11. A surgical procedure to remove a baby through incisions made in the abdomen and uterus
- 12. A surgical procedure to excise, or remove a bunion
- 13. The endoscopic examination of the large bowel and the distal part of the small bowel
- 14. A plastic surgery for correction and reconstructing the nose

- 1. The plastic surgery operation for correcting defects, deformities, and disfigurations of the eyelids

- 2. A surgical procedure to remove the foreskin; the skin that covers the tip of the penis
- 3. Surgical repair of a hernia
- 6. A surgery to move an undescended testicle into the scrotum and permanently fix it there
- 8. Inspection of the uterine cavity by endoscopy with access through the cervix
- 9. The surgical removal of the uterus
