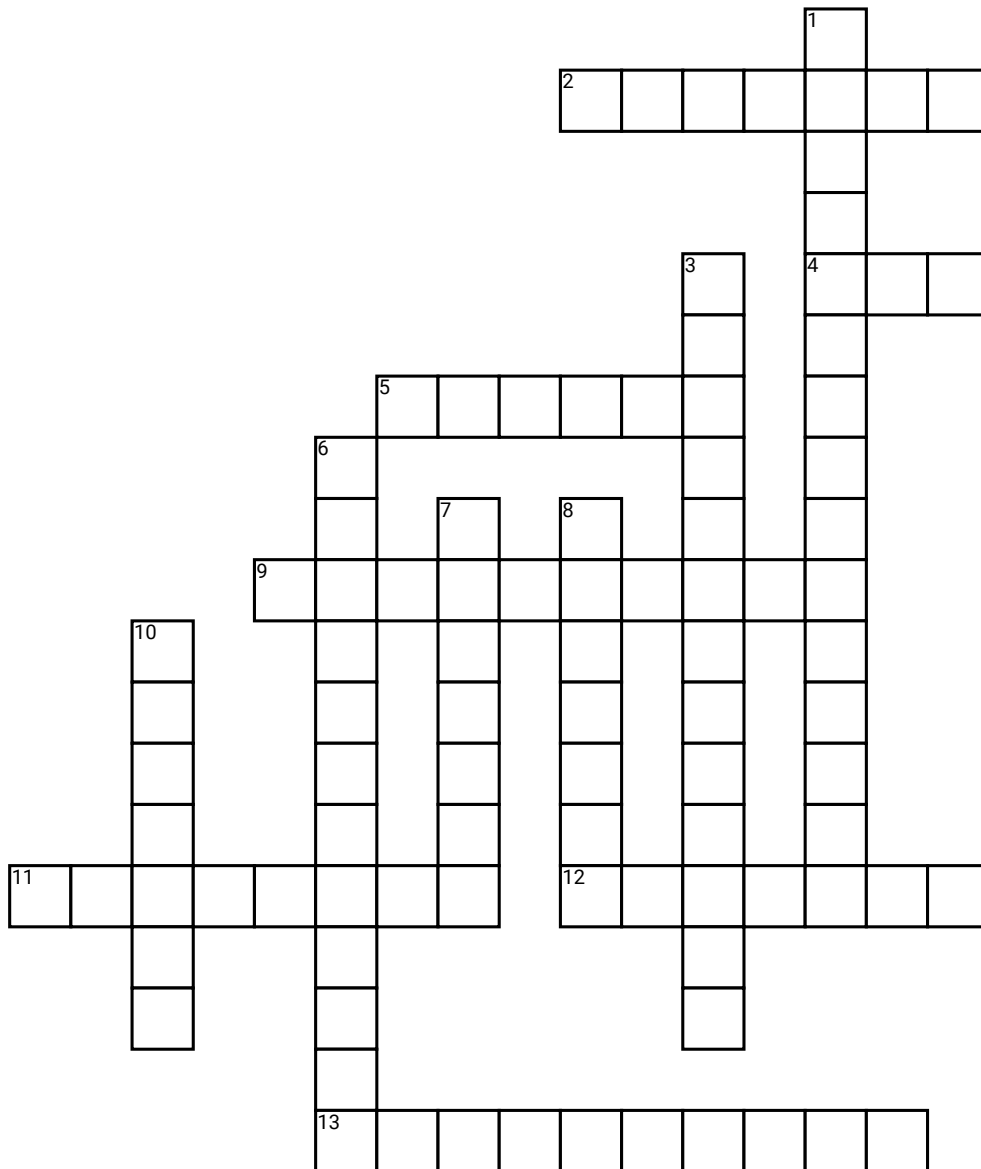


Surgical Tools (and Their Uses)

2. tool used to burn closed wounds and stop bleeding
 4. A metal operating instrument having an edge of sharp, toothlike projections, for dividing bone, cartilage, or plaster.
 5. stiches made to close up a wound or incision
 9. stopping bleeding (through clamping)
 11. Used for cutting sheets of tissue or blunt dissection

12. Small and extremely sharp bladed instrument used for skin and muscle incisions

13. separate edges of incision or wound/ hold back tissue to access area of the body that needs operating

1. tool used to stop flow of blood and close off blood vessels
 3. used to hold tissues or sponges in place

6. keeps suture steady and helps drive the needle into the skin

7. Used for precise clamping and come in many forms for specific purposes

8. can be used to close skin wounds. reduces inflammation, recovery time, and the size of the wound

10. remove blood from a certain area for better viewing
