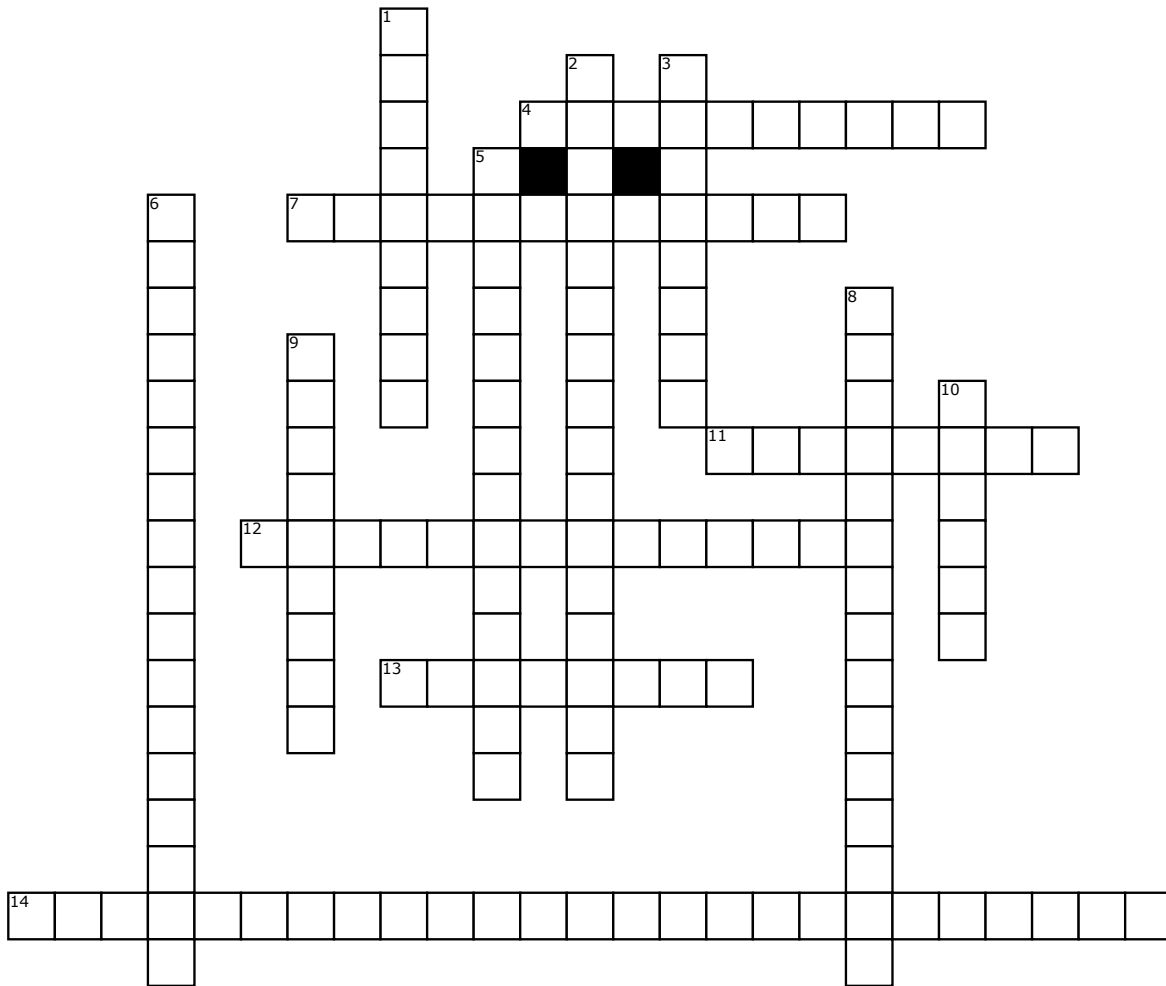


# THE AMERICAN REVOLUTION CROSSWORD PUZZLE
