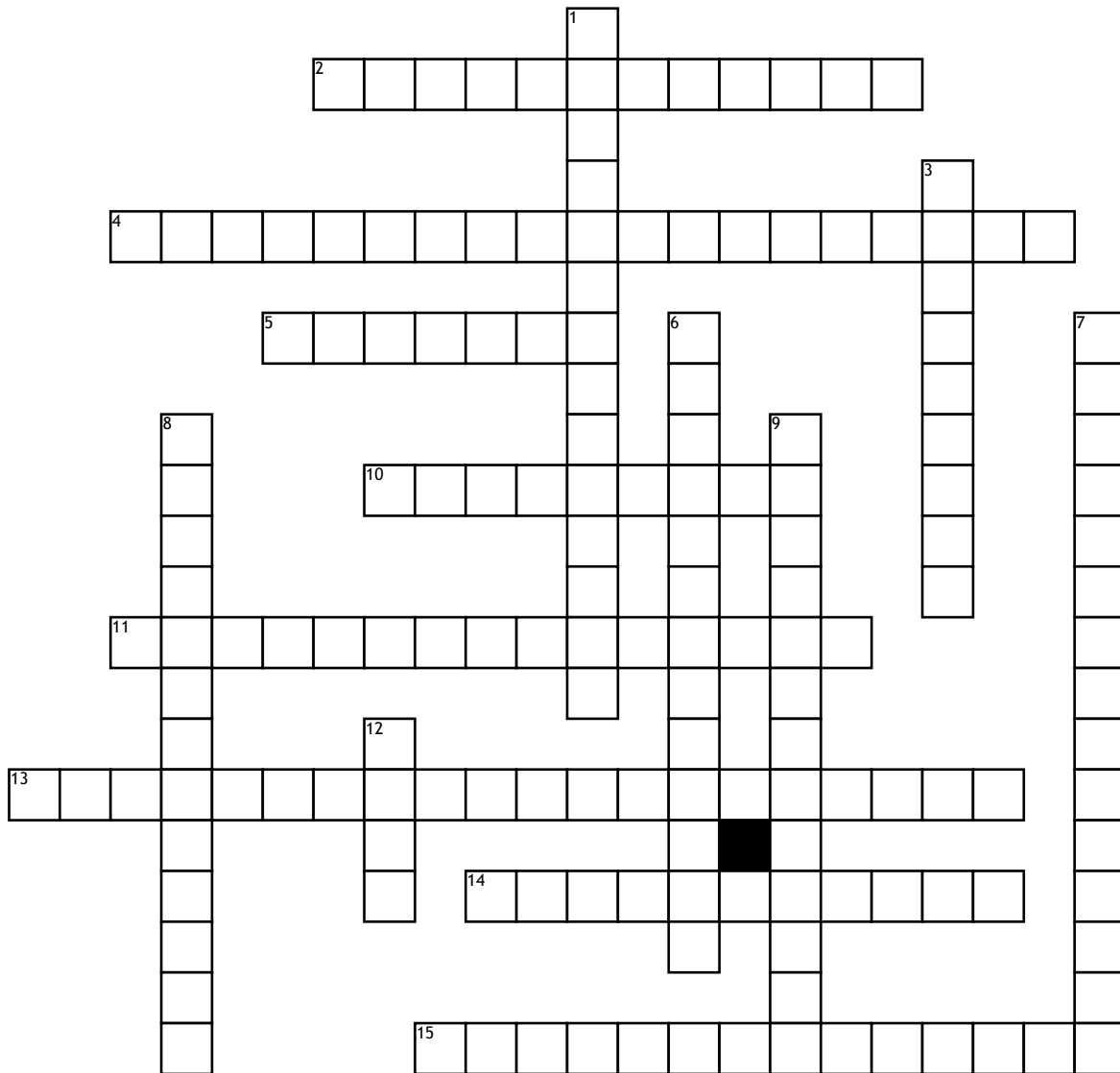


# THE MINERAL REVOLUTION
