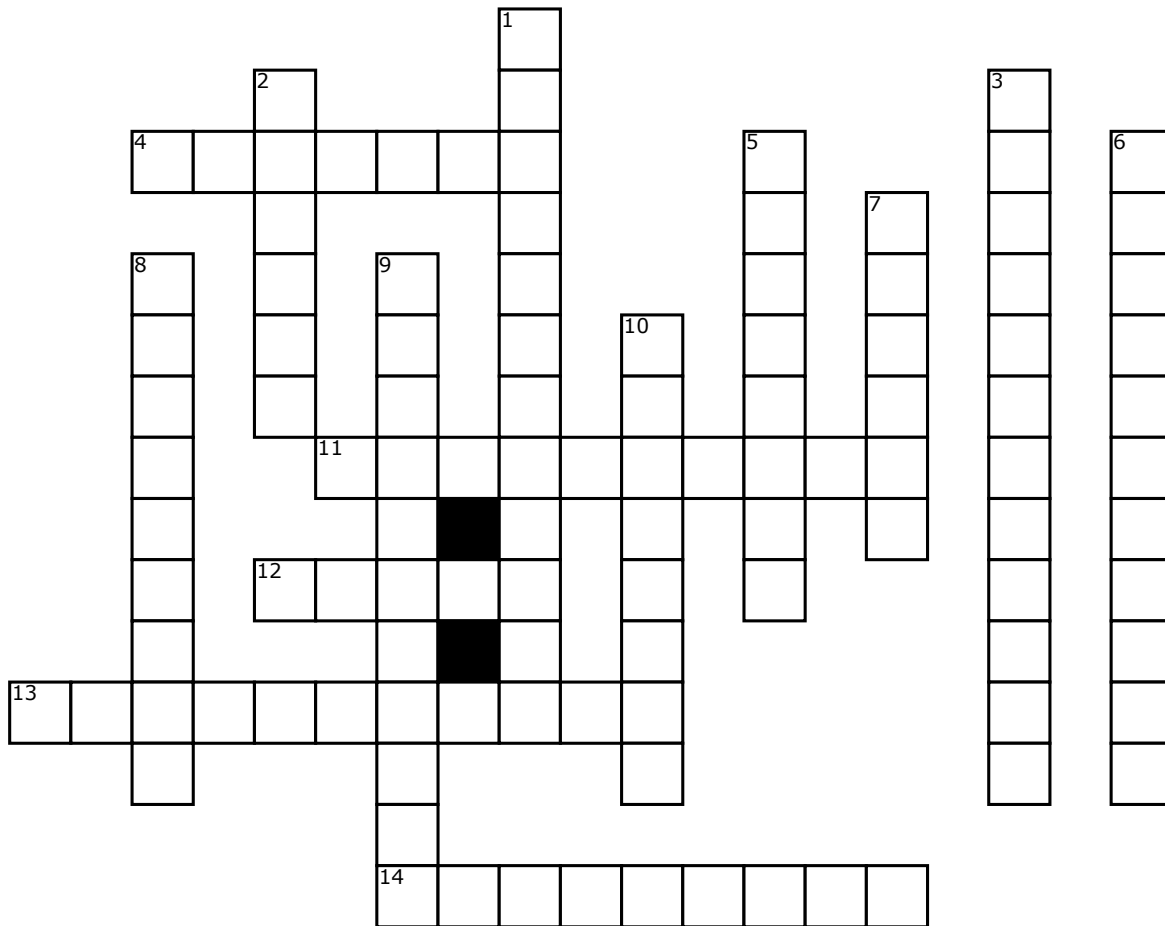


# The Haitian Revolution
