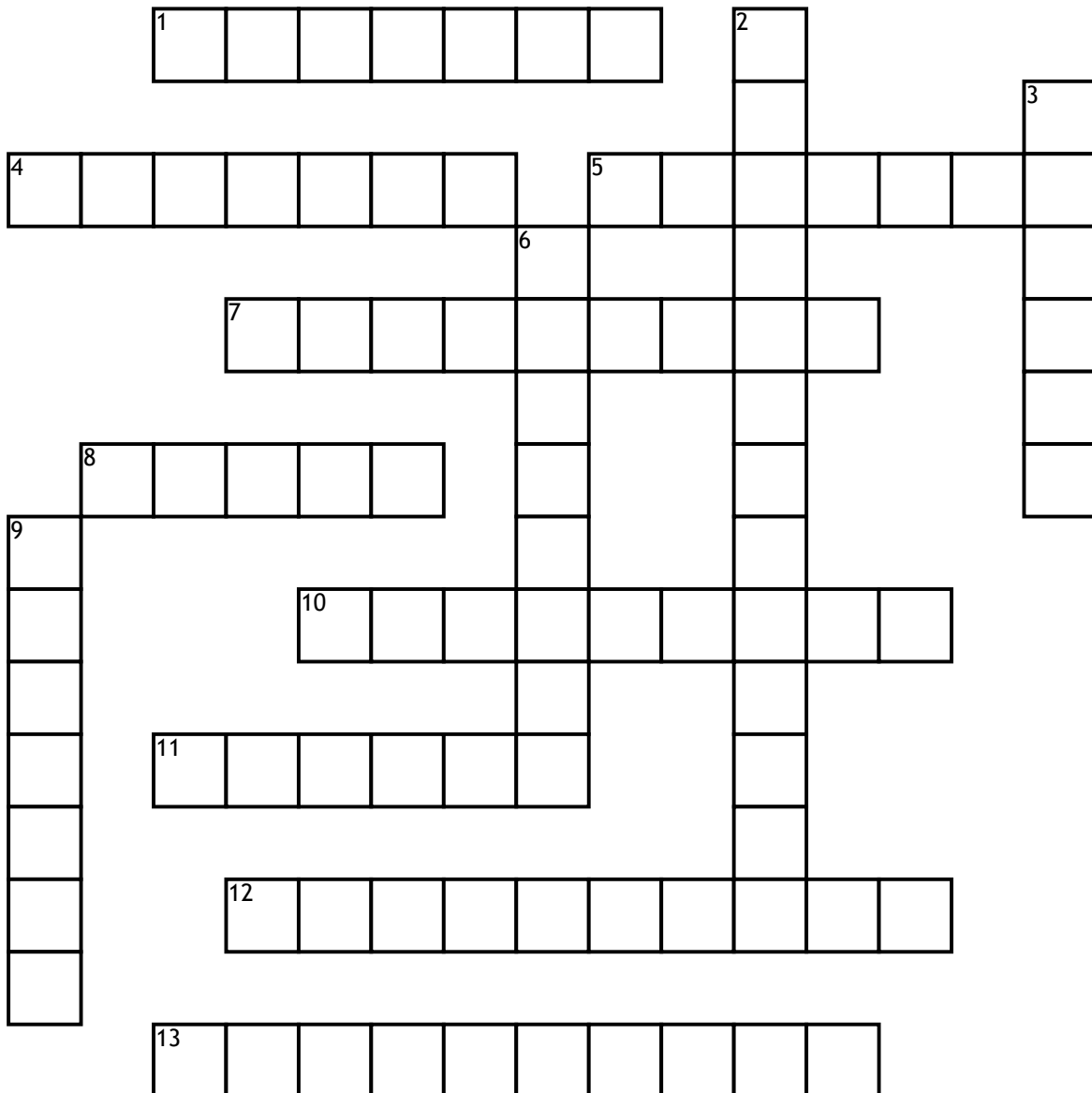


TKAMB Crossword Puzzle
