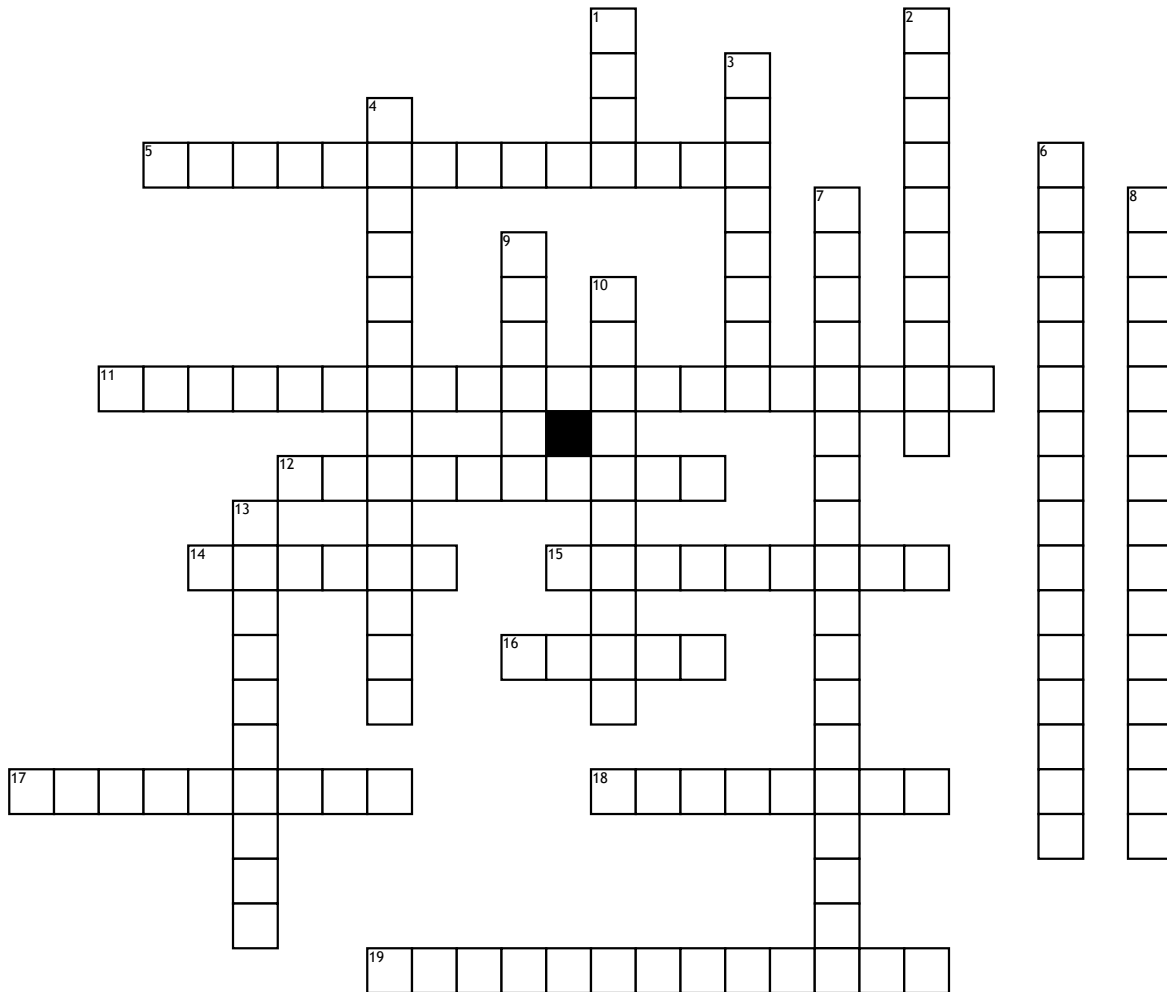

- 1. to arrange it alphabetically, numerically, or chronologically
- 2. column that uniquely identifies each row
- 3. controls the type of data a field will contain—whether it is text, number, date/time
- 4. An expression that limits the values that can be entered in the field
- 6. string that contains no characters & used to indicate that you know no value exists for a field.

7. stores information in separate tables and these tables are connected or linked by a defined relationship that ties the data together

8. lists the database tables and the fields they contain

9. a set of rules for determining which records will be displayed

10. primary key from one table is used in another table, this is used to reference the data from the primary key to help avoid redundancy

13. order sorts data from the end to the beginning, such as from Z to A, 10 to 1, and December to January
