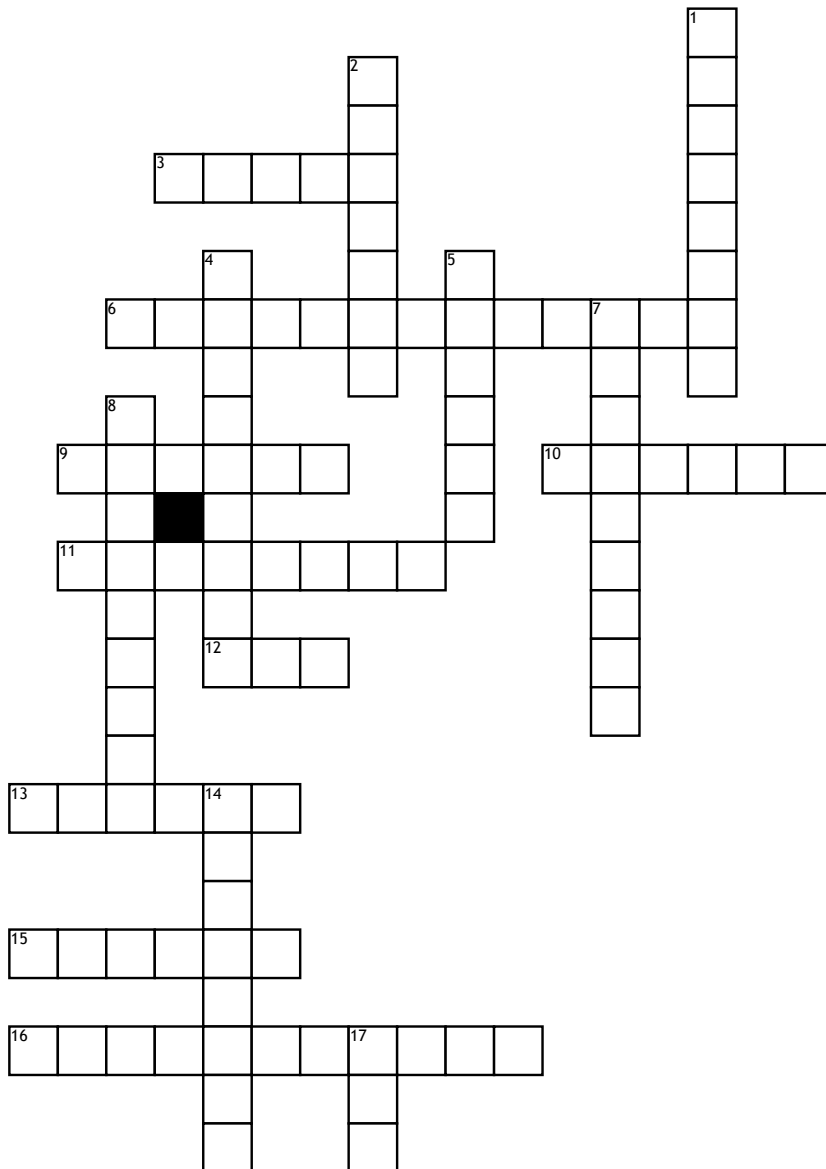


# Task 1: Work in the Animal Care Industry
