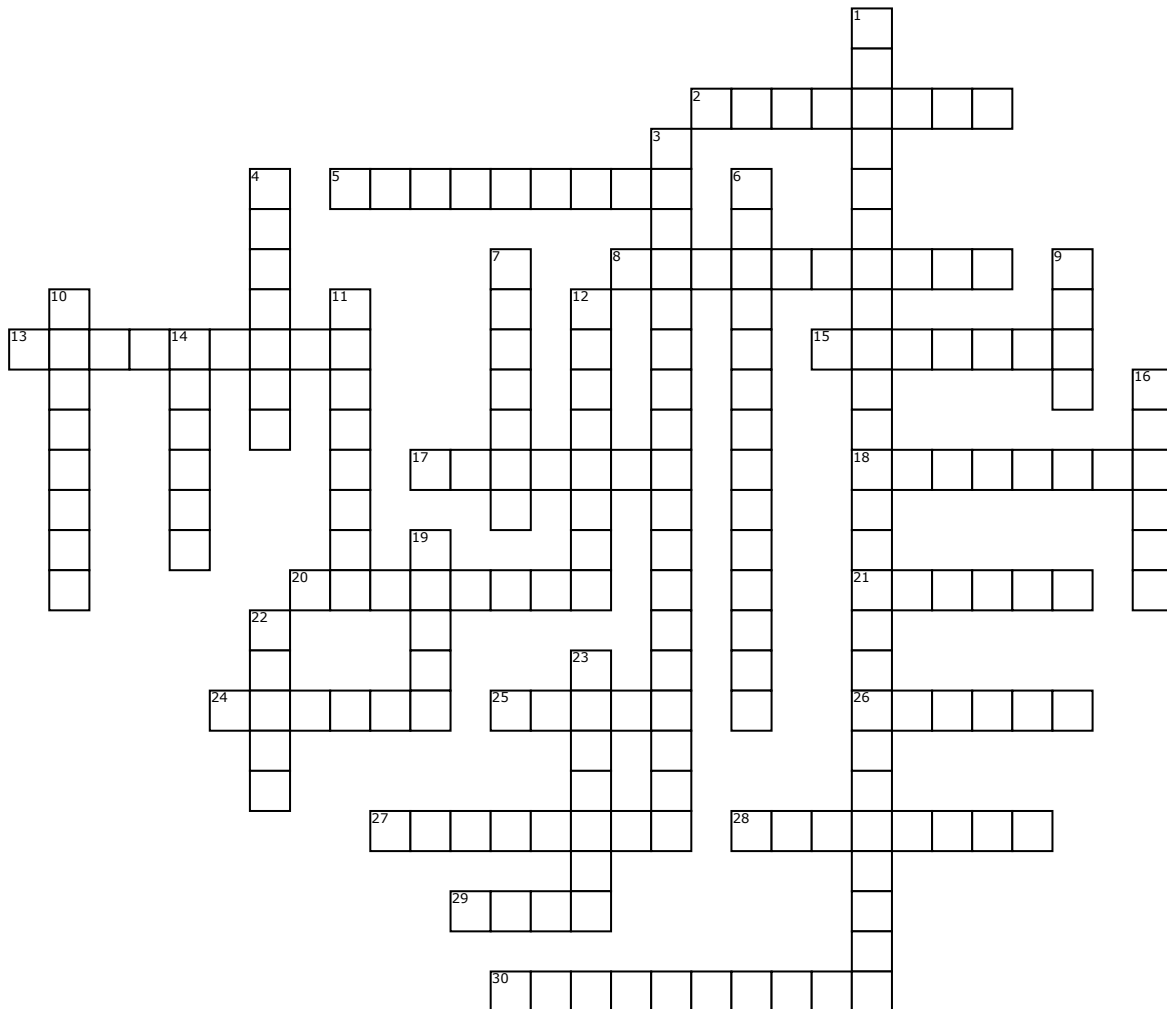


# Texas Revolution Crossword
