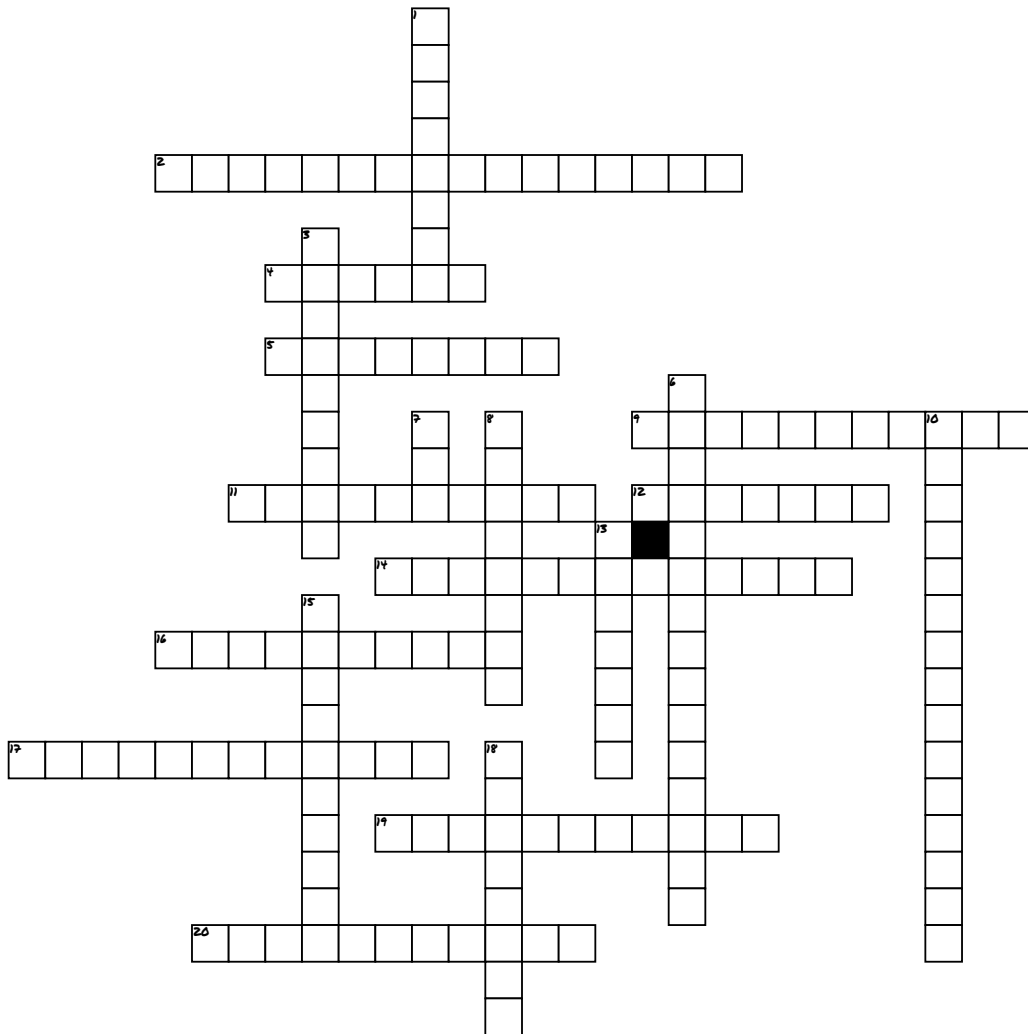

- 2. IS A RAPID AND OFTEN UNANTICIPATED DROP IN STOCK PRICES
- 4. HERBERT HOOVER WAS THE 31ST PRESIDENT TO TAKE OFFICE IN 1929 WHEN THE STOCK-MARKET CRASHED PLUNGING THE COUNTRY IN GREAT DEPRESSION
- 5. AN AREA OF LAND WHERE VEGETATION HAS BEEN LOST AND SOIL REDUCED TO DUST AND ERODED, ESPECIALLY AS A CONSEQUENCE OF DROUGHT OR UNSUITABLE FARMING PRACTICE

- 6. THE ECONOMIC CRISIS AND PERIOD OF LOW BUSINESS ACTIVITY IN THE U.S. AND THE OTHER COUNTRIES ROUGHLY BEGINNING WITH THE STOCK-MARKET CRASH IN OCTOBER, 1929 AND CONTINUING THROUGH MOST OF THE 1930'S

- 8. TO PUT TO DEATH, ESPECIALLY BY HANGING BY MOB ACTION AND WITHOUT LEGAL AUTHORITY
- 10. AN ARRANGEMENT FOR PAYMENT BY INSTALLMENTS
- 13. THE ECONOMIC MEASURES INTRODUCED BY PRESIDENT FRANKLIN D ROOSEVELT IN 1933 TO COUNTERACT THE EFFECTS OF THE GREAT DEPRESSION. IT INVOLVES A MASSIVE PUBLIC WORKS PROGRAM COMPLEMENTED BY THE LARGER-SCALE GRANTING OF LOANS AND SUCCEED IN REDUCING UNEMPLOYMENT BY BETWEEN 7 TO 10 MILLION
- 15. A MARKET IN WHICH SHARE PRICES ARE RISING ENCOURAGING BUYING
- 18. FASHIONABLE YOUNG WOMAN INTENT ON ENJOYING HERSELF AND FLOUTING CONVENTIONAL STANDARDS OF BEHAVIOR.
