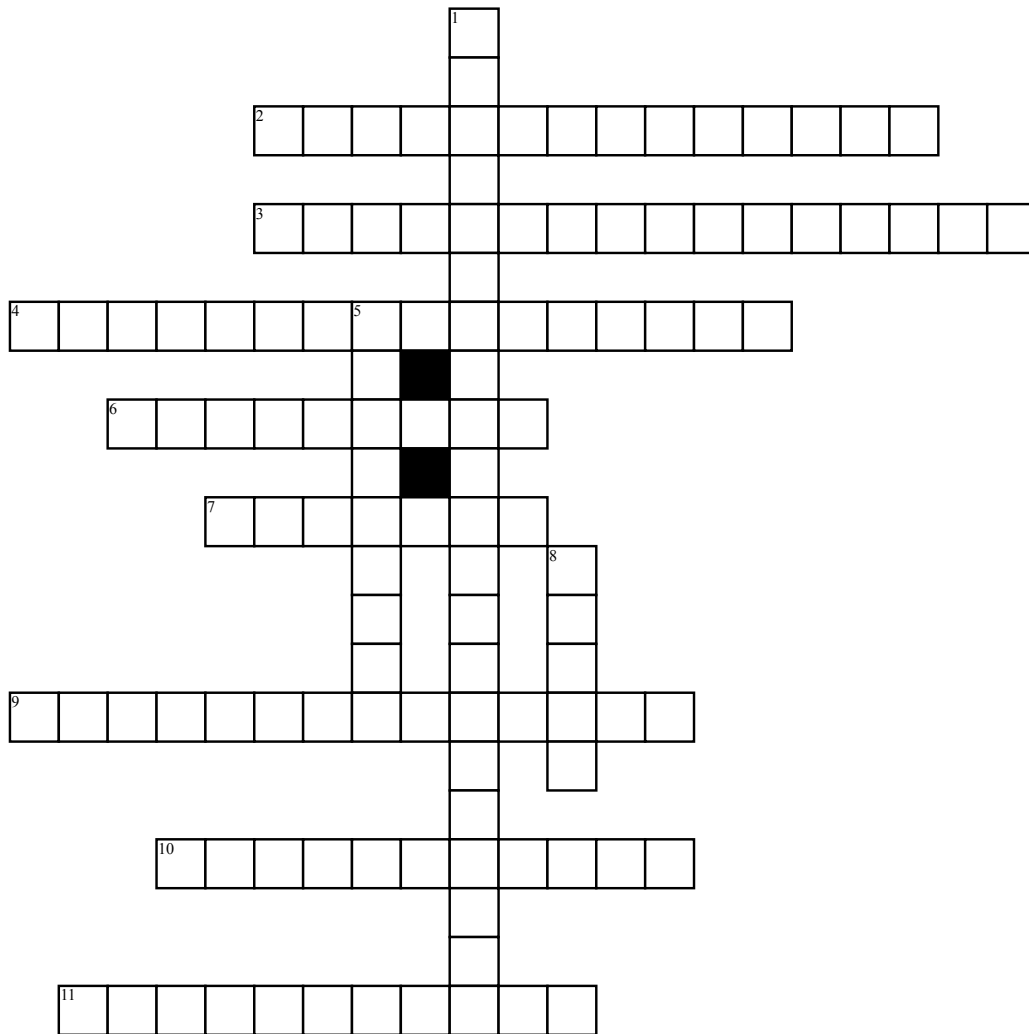


# The 1970's in the United States

- 2. Followed the resignation of Nixon after the Watergate Scandal.
- 3. Five members of CREEP caught wiretapping phones and stealing documents in the office of the Democratic National Committee.
- 4. ended Egyptian-Israeli disputes; conducted by President Carter
- 6. Reserve of money for illicit purposes
- 7. An official ban on trade or other commercial activity w/ a particular country
- 9. Leaked classified information about US' involvement in the Vietnam war that Nixon felt would be damaging to his administration.

- 10. persistent high inflation combined with high unemployment and stagnant demand in a country's economy.

- 11. A charge of misconduct made against the holder of a public office.

- 1. Nixon's act of firing Archibald Cox, which led to the resignation of Supreme Justice Officials and protest
- 5. a general increase in pricing and the fall in the purchasing value of money
- 8. Organization of Arab Petroleum Exporting Countries (imposed oil embargo on U.S.)
