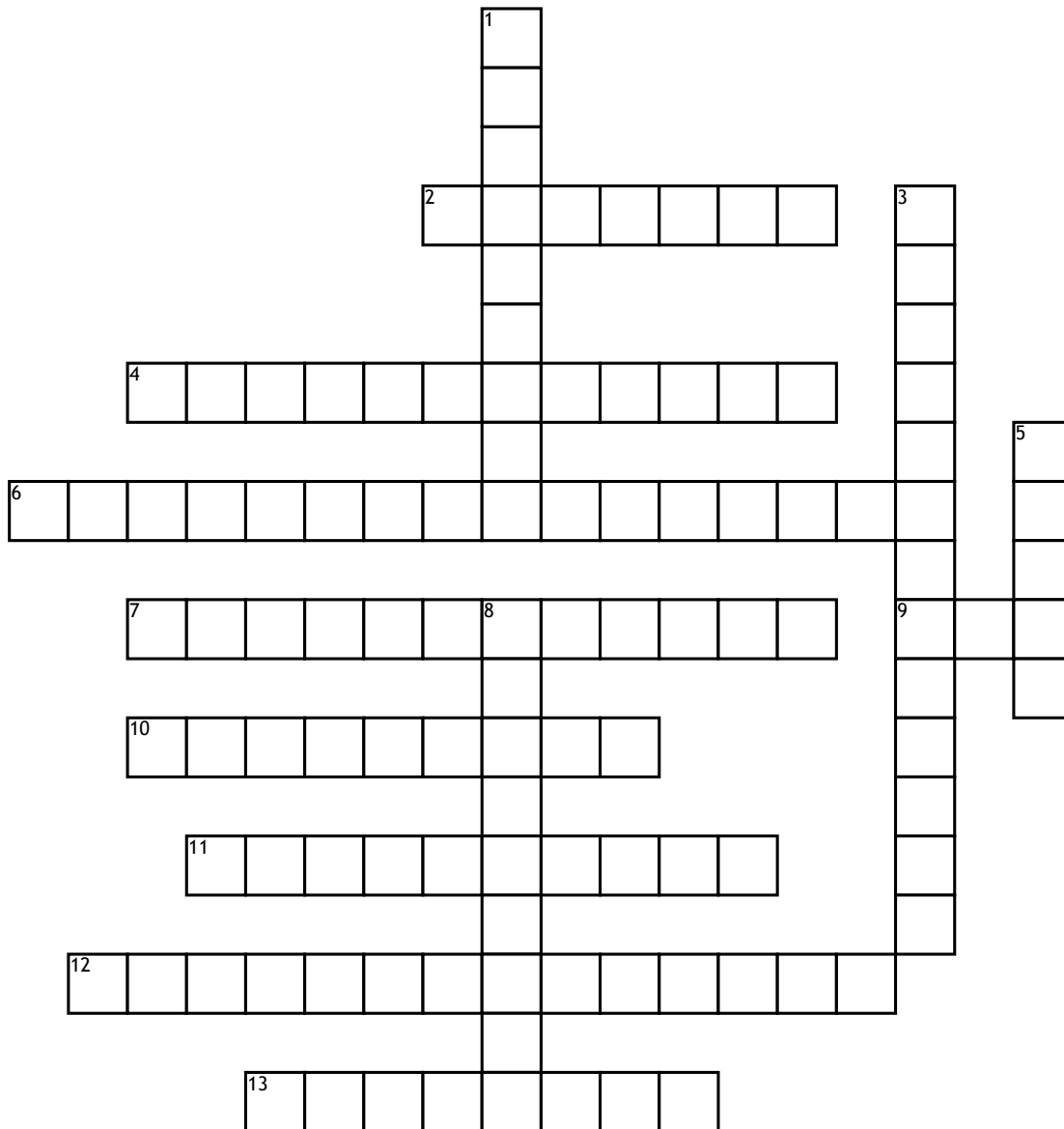


The Amazing Crossword
