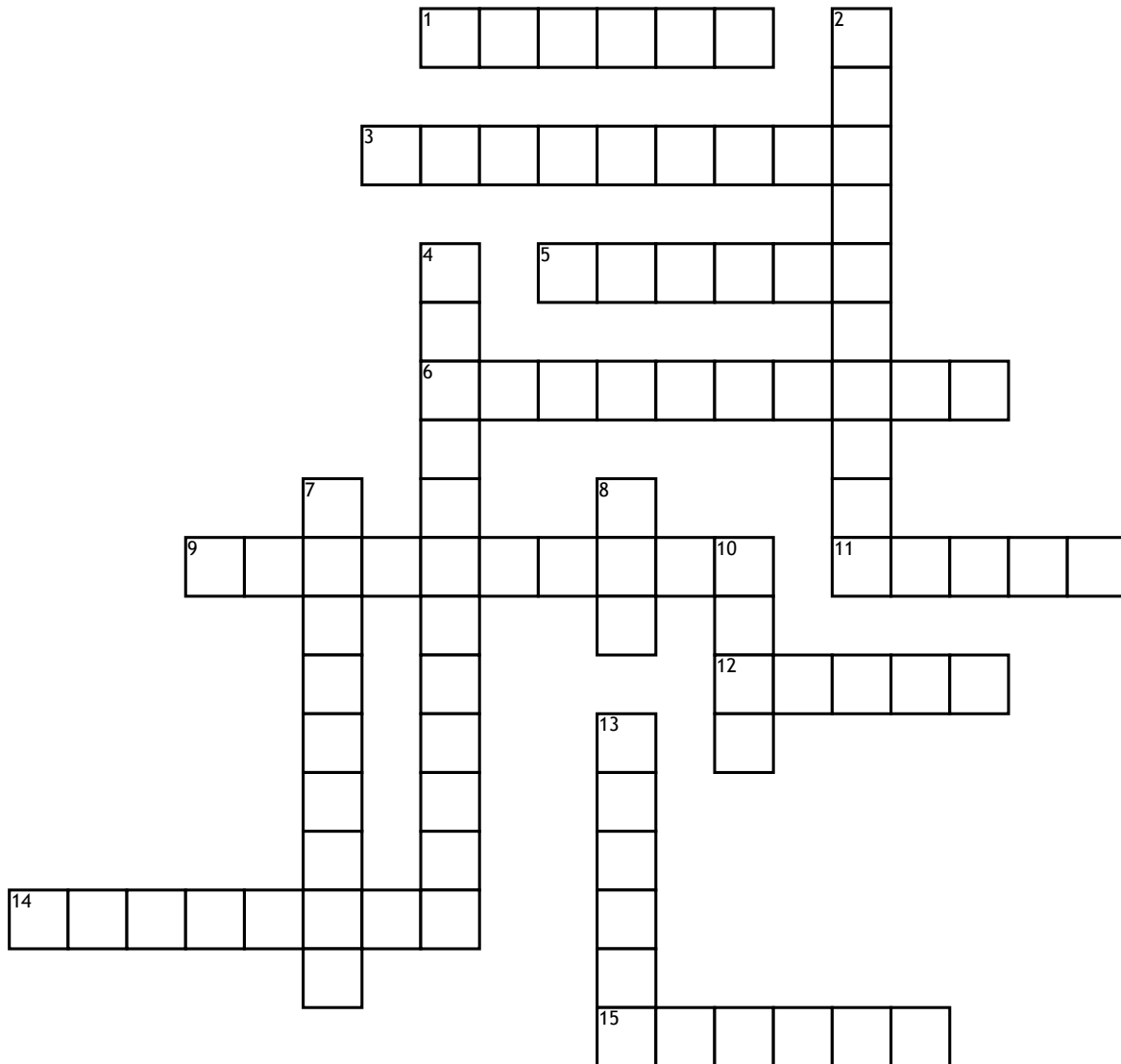


"The Bet" Crossword Puzzle
