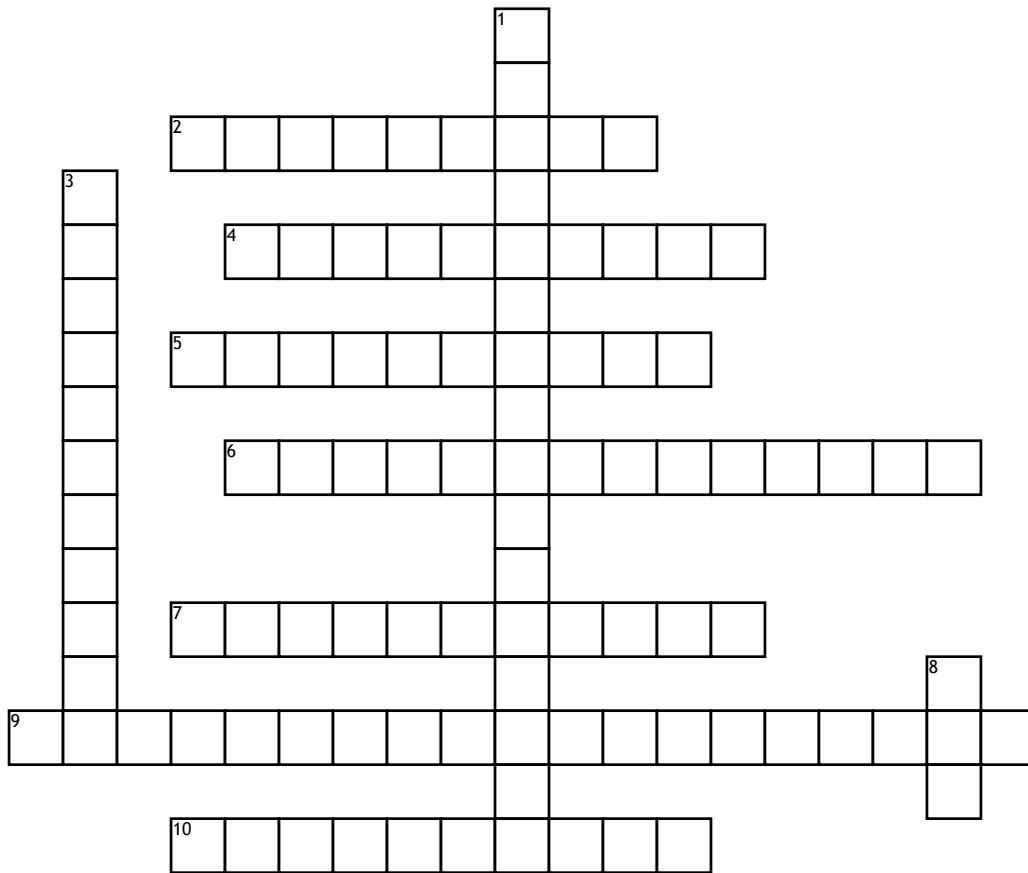


The Carbon Cycle
