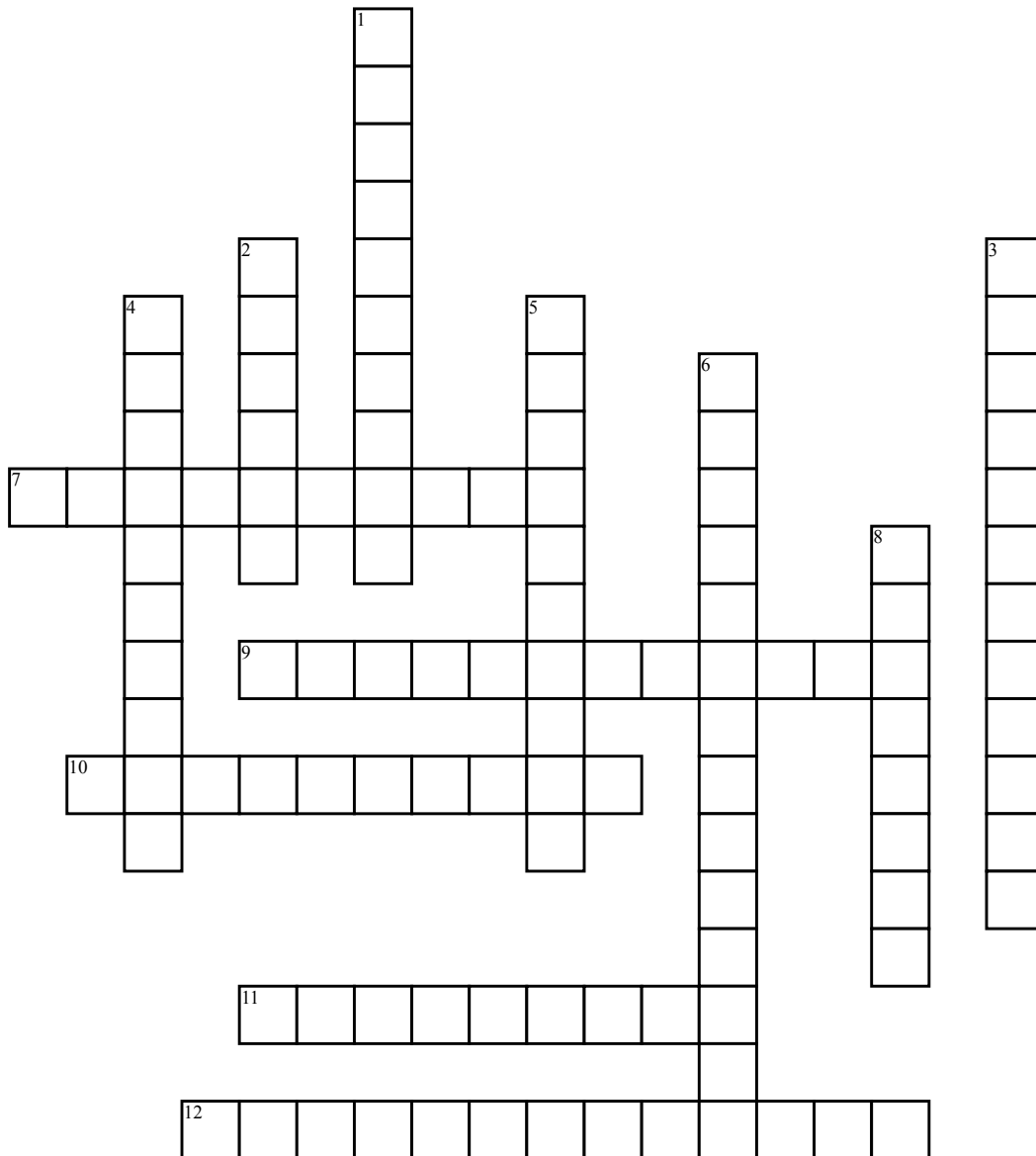


# The Children's Crusade
