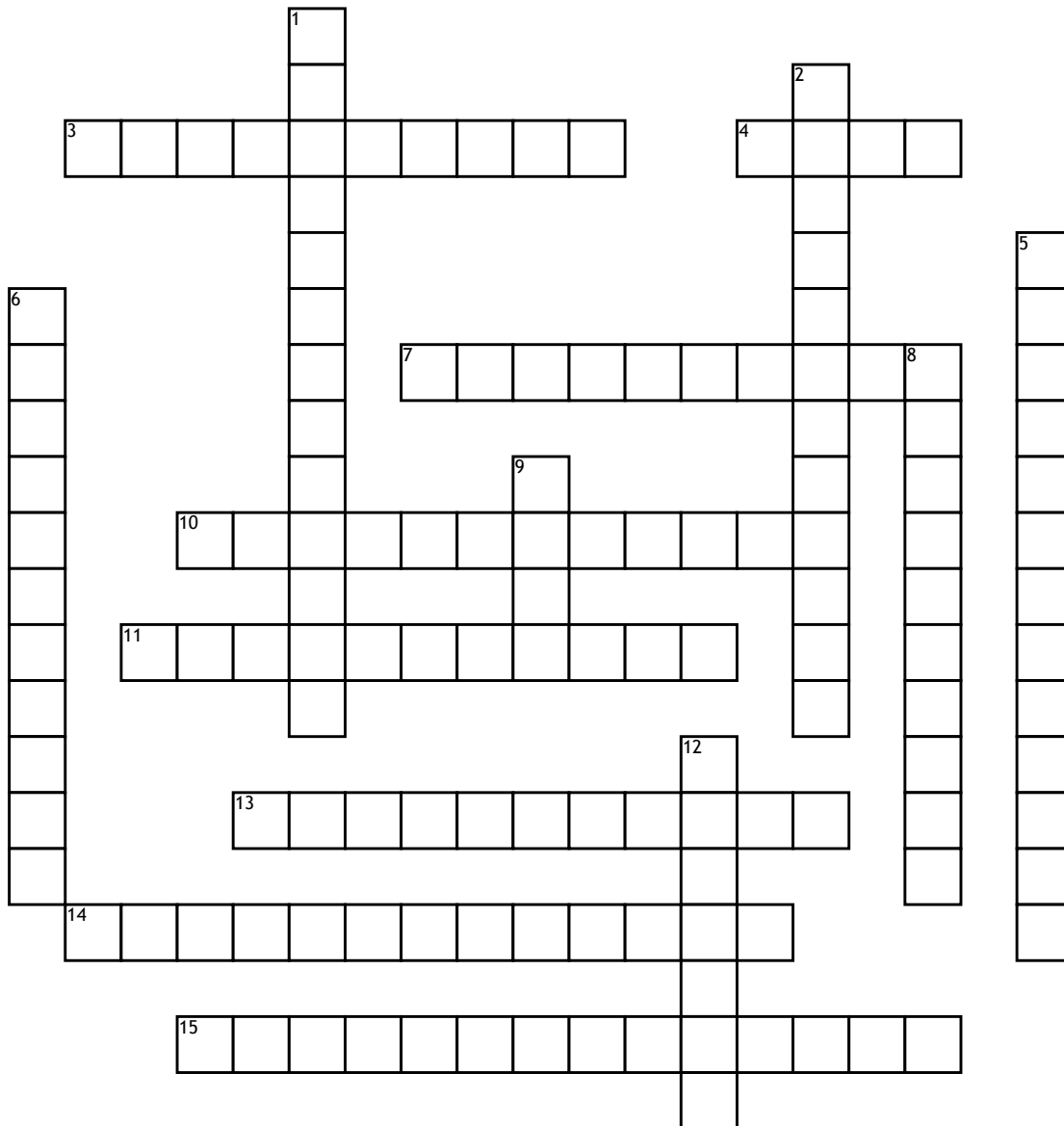


The Cold War Crossword
