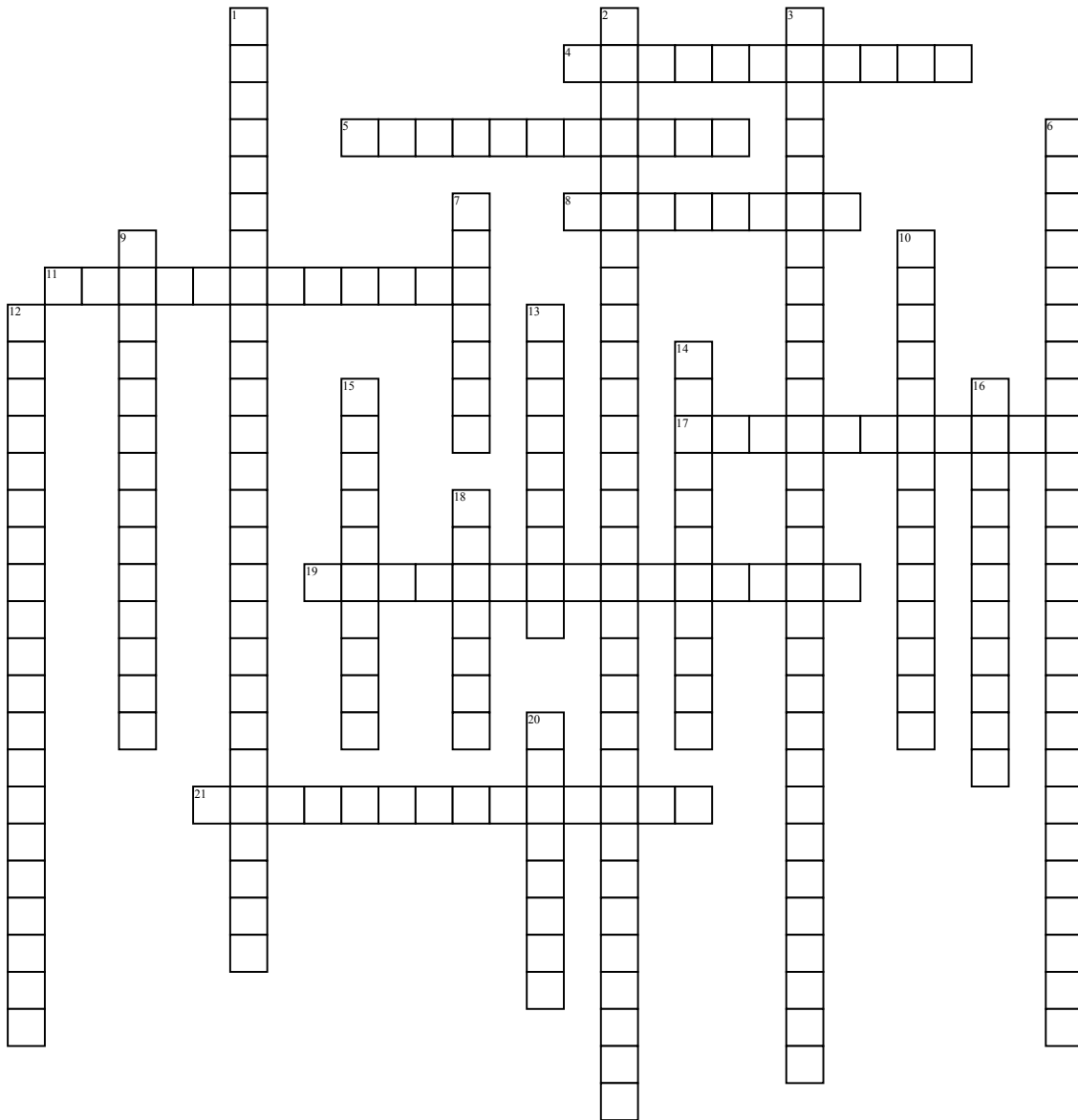


The Cold War and Social Transformations crossword puzzle words/definitions
