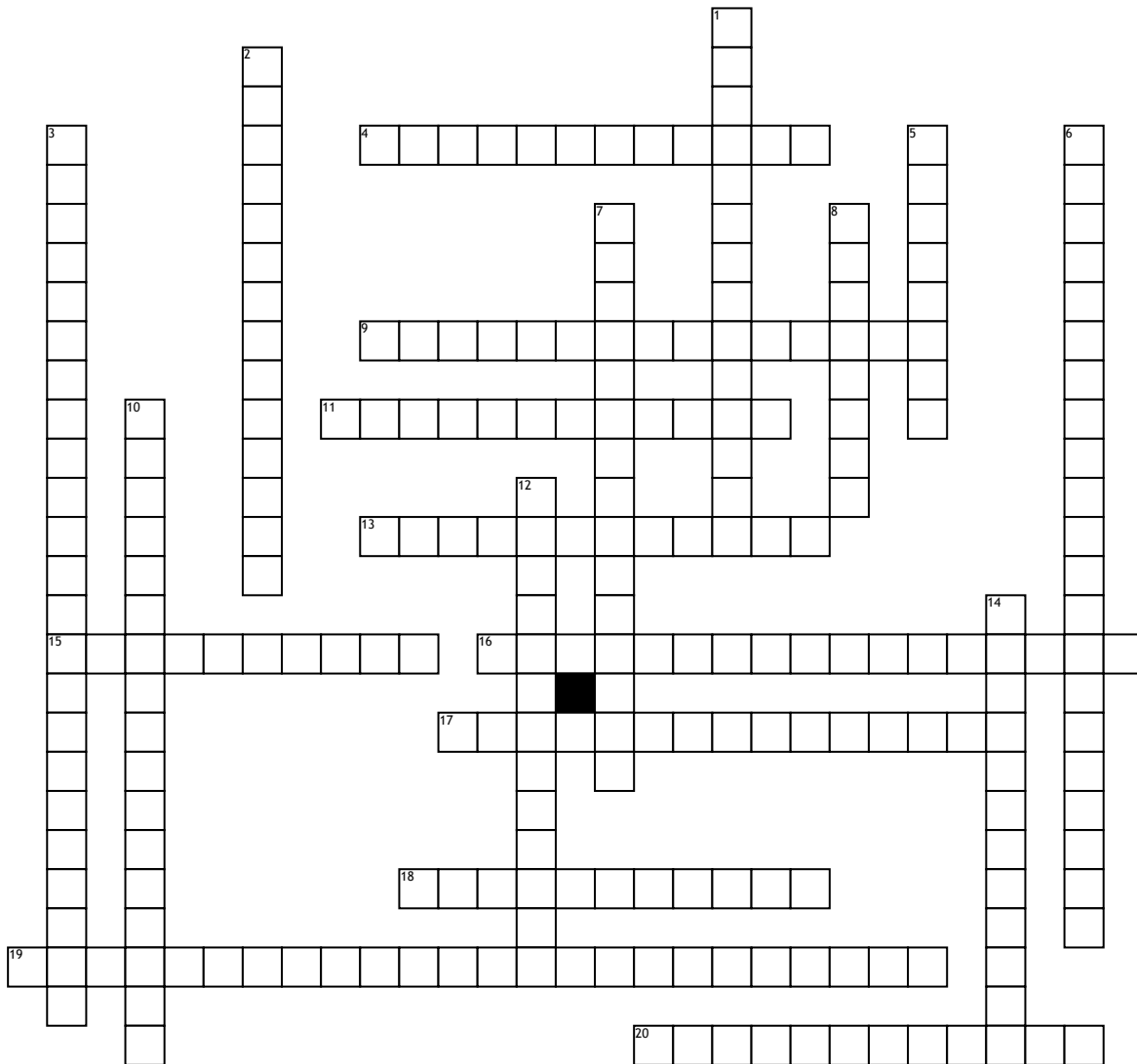


The Constitution
