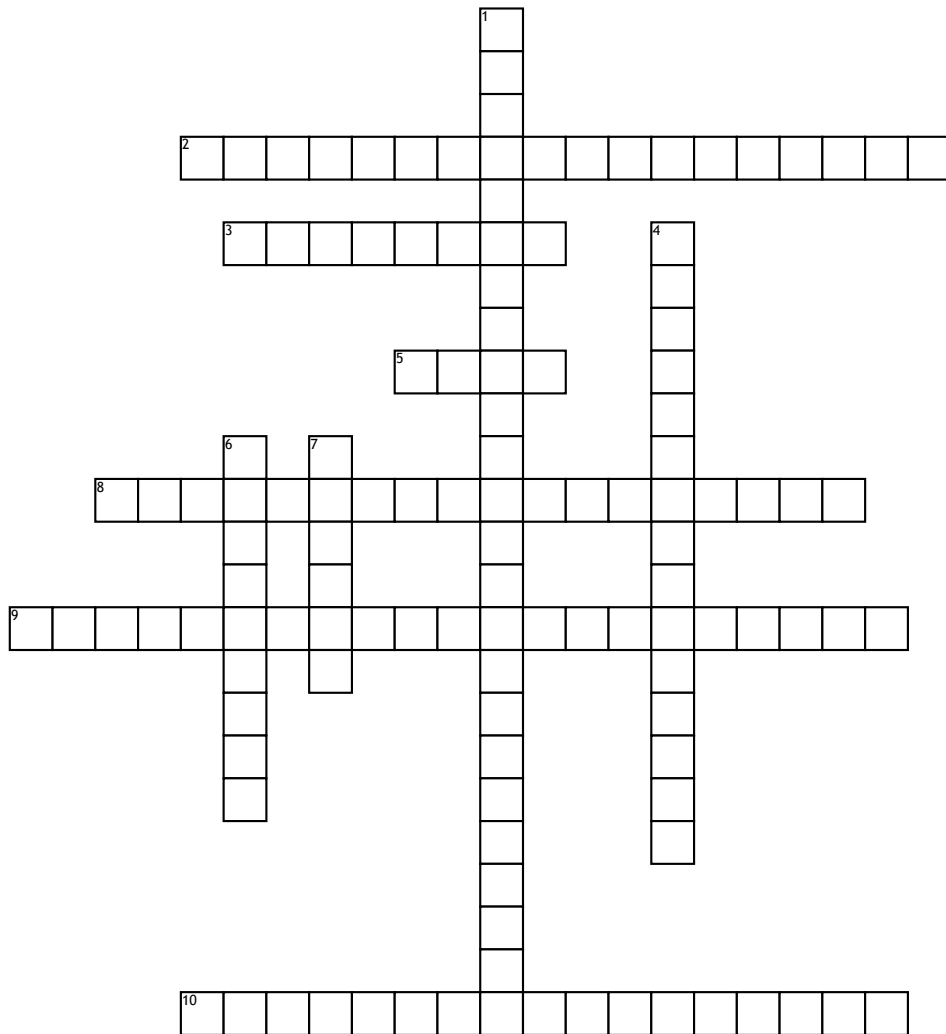

9. An agreement at the Constitutional Convention in 1787 to count 3/5 of the entire slave population for purposes of taxation and representation
10. A system of limits built into the Constitution to prevent any of the three branches of government having too much power

1. A meeting in Philadelphia in May 1787, of the Founding Fathers who wrote the Constitution
4. A middle ground between plans of government proposed by the large states and plans supported by the smaller states on the issue of how states would be represented in Congress
