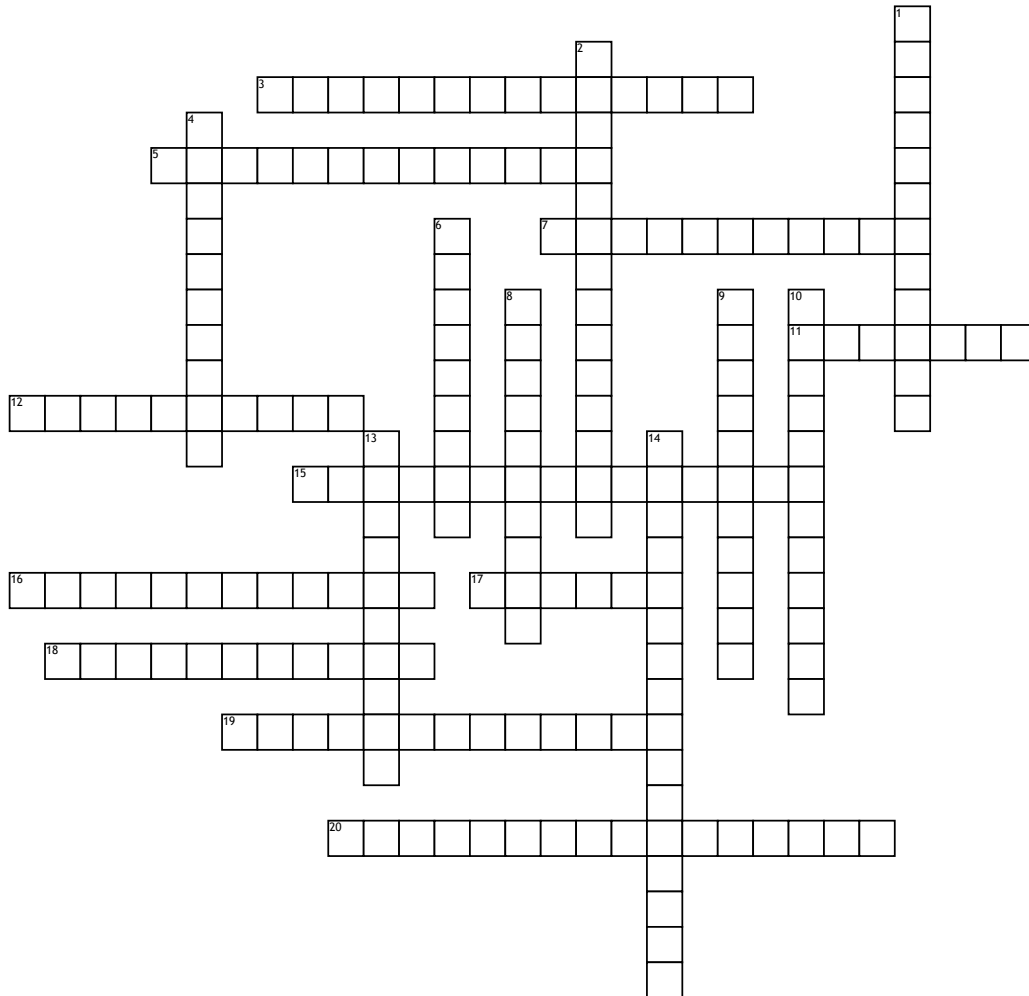


# The Crucible Crossword
