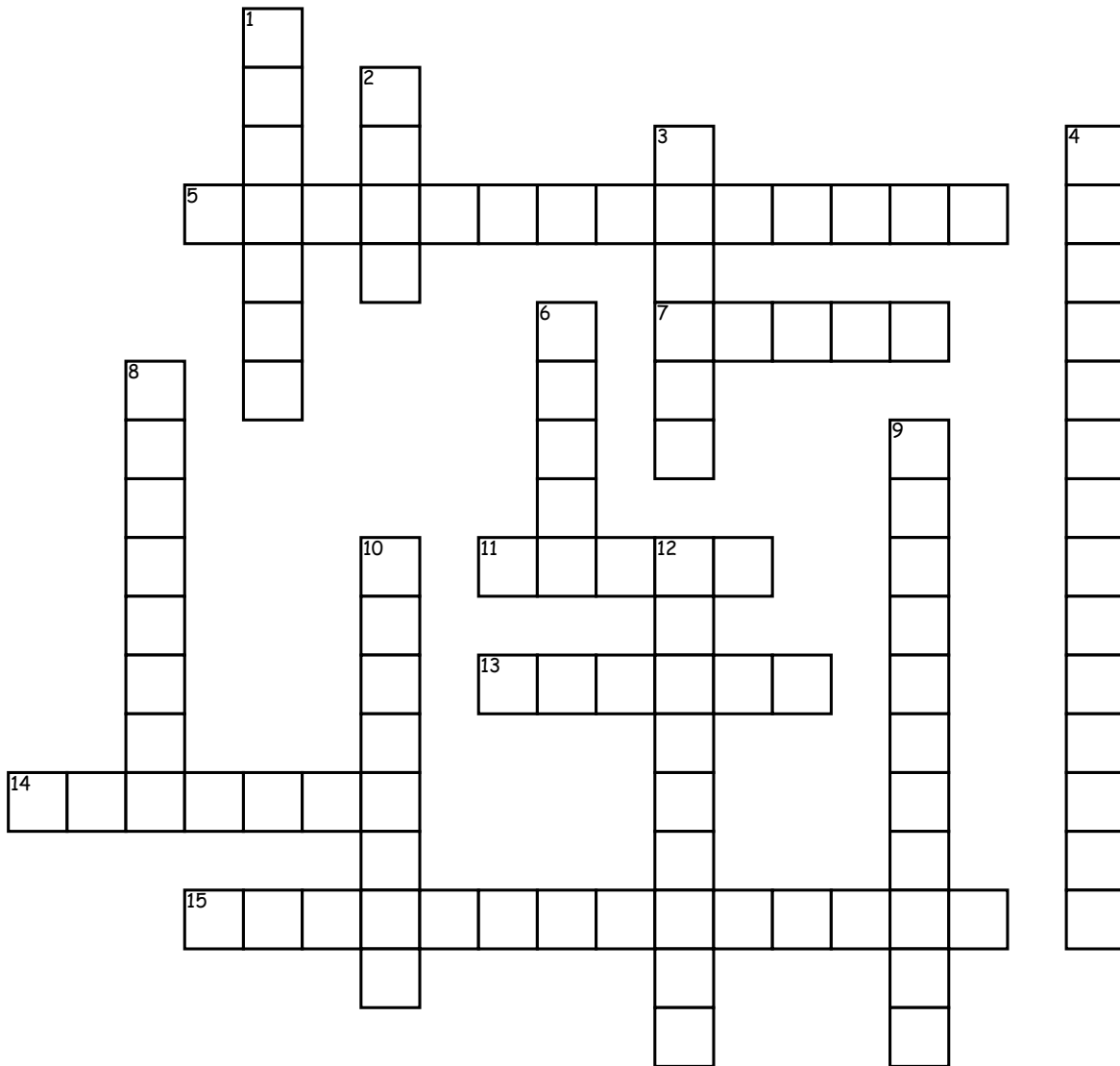


# The Digestive System



## Across

- 5.** absorbs nutrients and minerals from food
- 7.** These chew food
- 11.** produces proteins that are important in blood clotting
- 13.** plays an important role in digestion by making sure that food goes down the esophagus
- 14.** allows your body to use sugar
- 15.** These help break down carbohydrates and other food. Found in the head

## Down

- 1.** receives food from the esophagus, it gives acid and enzymes that digest food
- 2.** This helps with digestion. It breaks down fats into fatty acids
- 3.** waste leaves body through this
- 4.** This body parts 's job is to absorb water from the remaining leftovers
- 6.** These are in the small intestine, look like plush carpet

- 8.** produces digestive juices to further break down food after it has left the stomach.
- 9.** a pear-shaped, hollow pouch located under the liver
- 10.** a narrow tube-shaped pouch next to the large intestine and located in the lower right side of the abdomen
- 12.** a "passage way" for food from the mouth to the stomach
