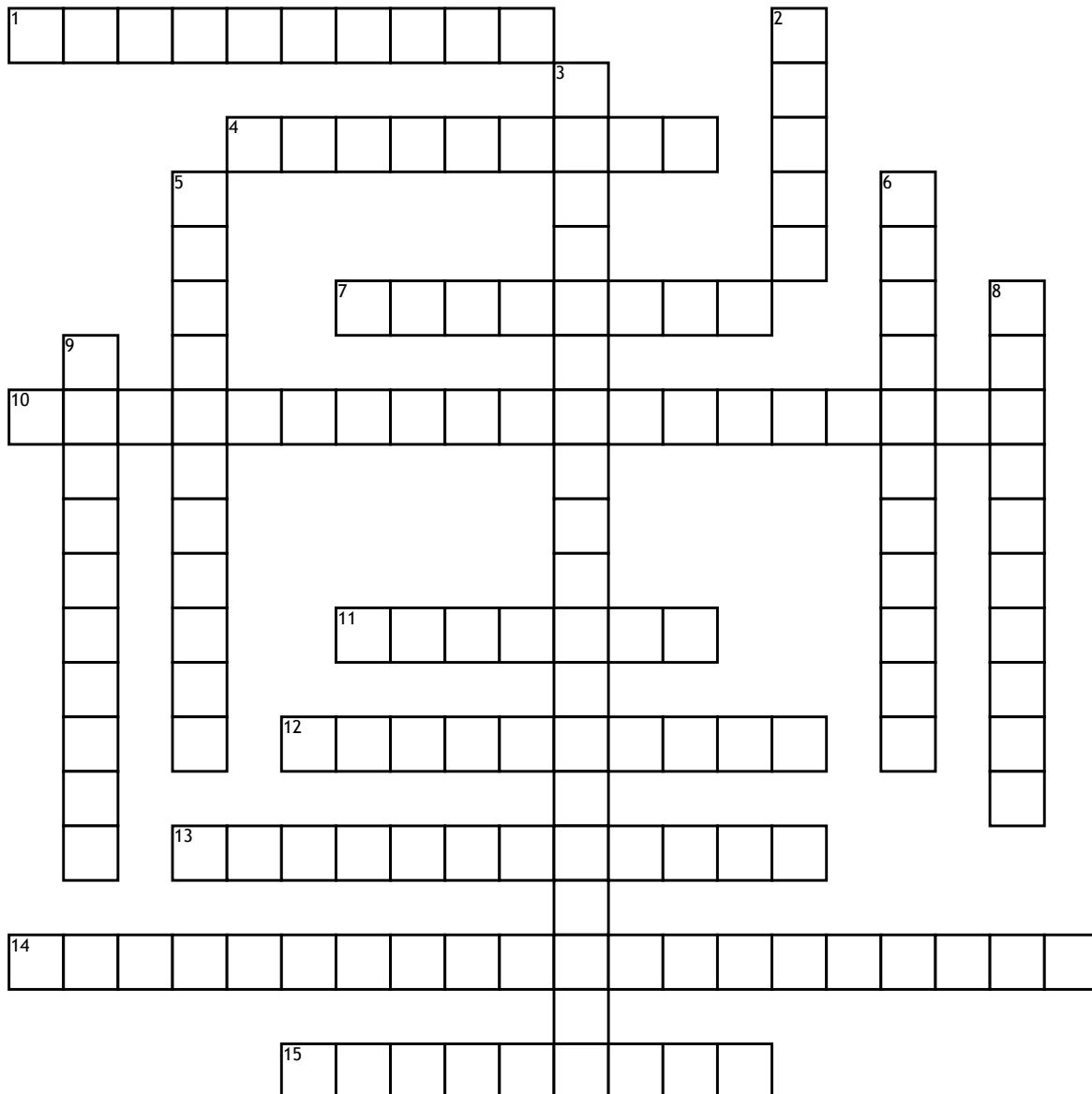


The Effects of Alcohol on the Body
