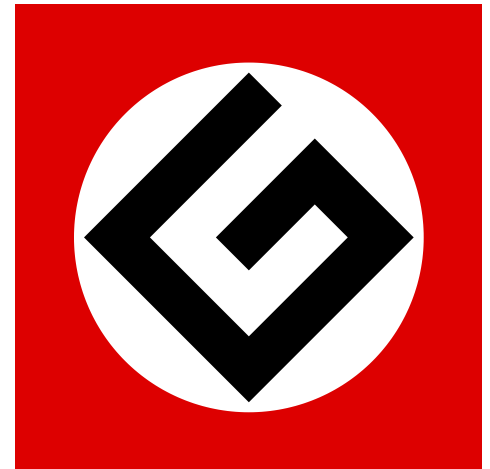
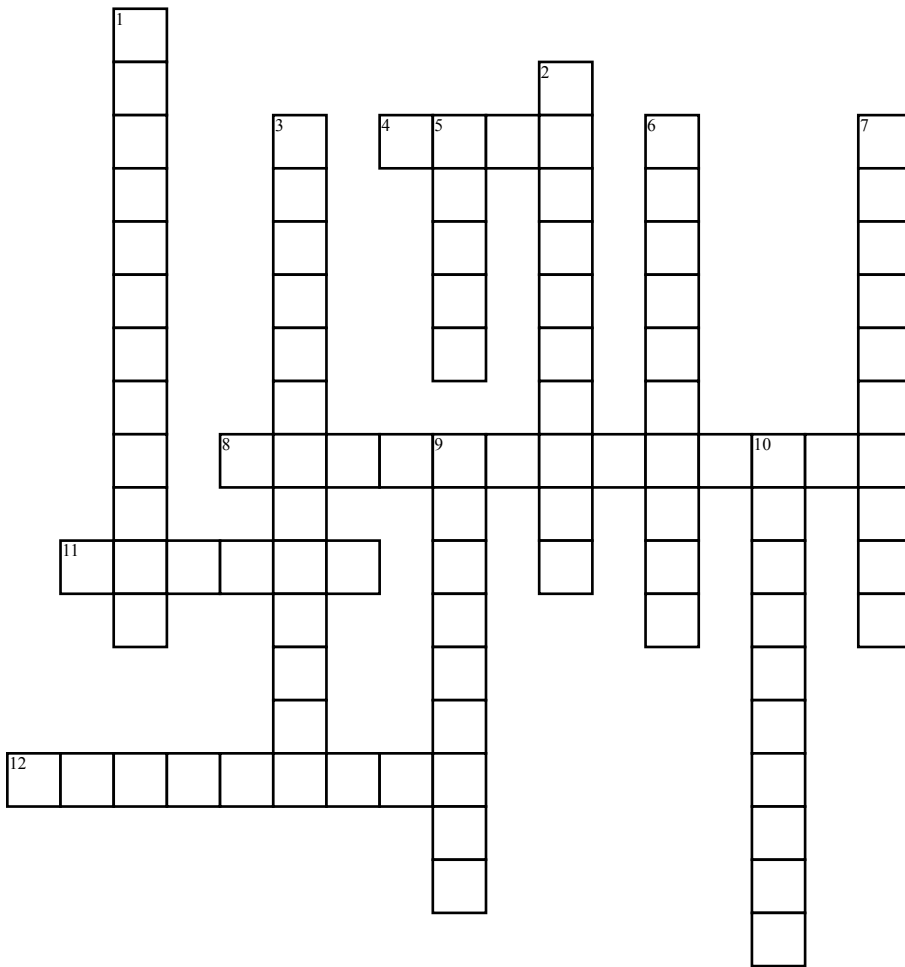


# The Enabling Act
