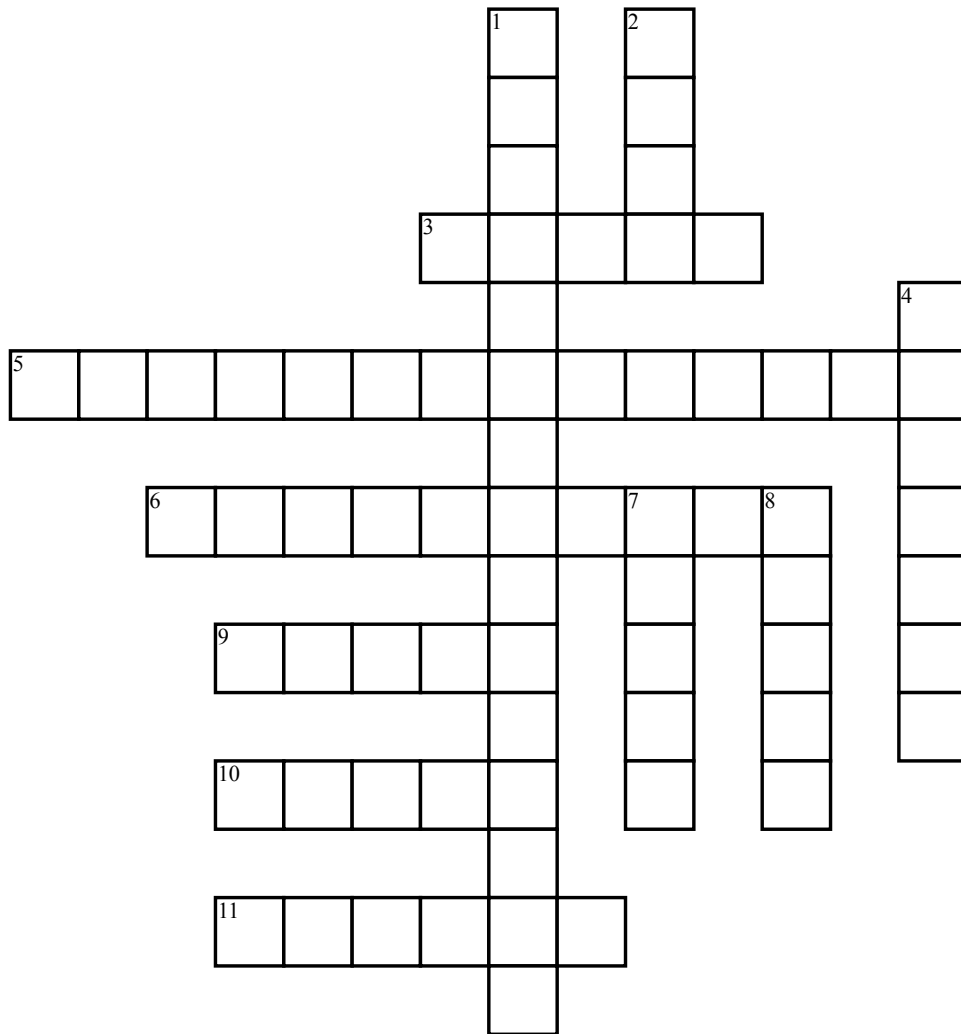

- 10. An organ that removes a certain type of waste from your blood called carbon dioxide

- 11. Two bean shaped organs that help filter the waste out of your blood

- 1. A system that removes unnecessary materials from the body
- 2. A layer of tissue that removes extra waste from sweat
- 4. Filtering units inside of the kidneys
- 7. An organ that converts excess amino acid in the blood stream to urea
- 8. The release of liquid through the body's skin
