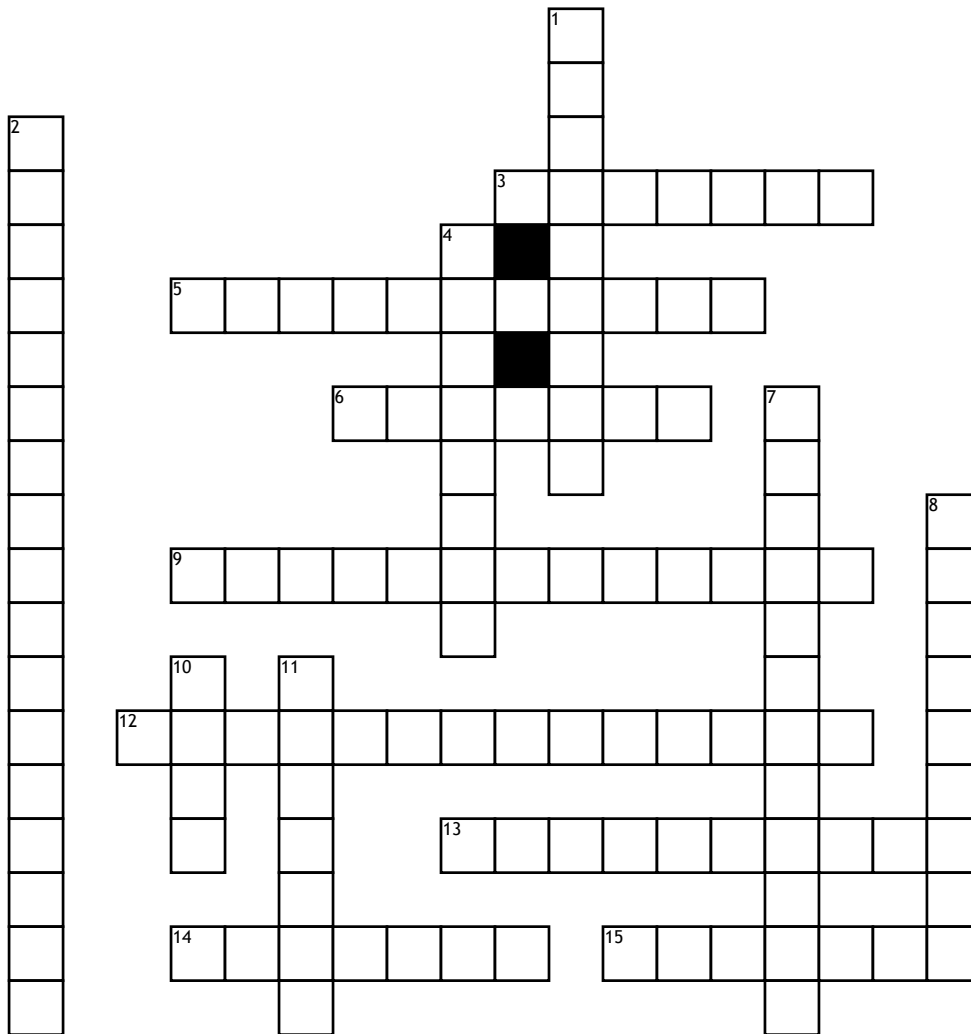


The Excretory System



Across

- 3. duct through which urine is discharged in most mammals and which serves as the male genital duct
- 5. a solid formation made from urine
- 6. any of the small tubules that are the excretory units of the vertebrate kidney
- 9. a muscle that contracts without conscious control and found in walls of internal organs such as stomach and intestine and bladder and blood vessels

- 12. a muscle that is connected at either or both ends to a bone and so move parts of the skeleton; a muscle that is characterized by transverse stripes
- 13. the lining of the bladder
- 14. a pair of thick-walled tubes that carry urine from the kidney to the urinary bladder
- 15. two bean-shaped excretory organs that filter wastes (especially urea) from the blood and excrete them and water in urine

- 1. the name of this system
- 2. muscle used to hold urine in the bladder
- 4. the main skeletal muscle disease
- 7. a pair of complex endocrine glands situated near the kidney
- 8. outermost layer of skin
- 10. any of the small tubules that are the excretory units of the vertebrate kidney
- 11. a distensible membranous sac (usually containing liquid or gas)
