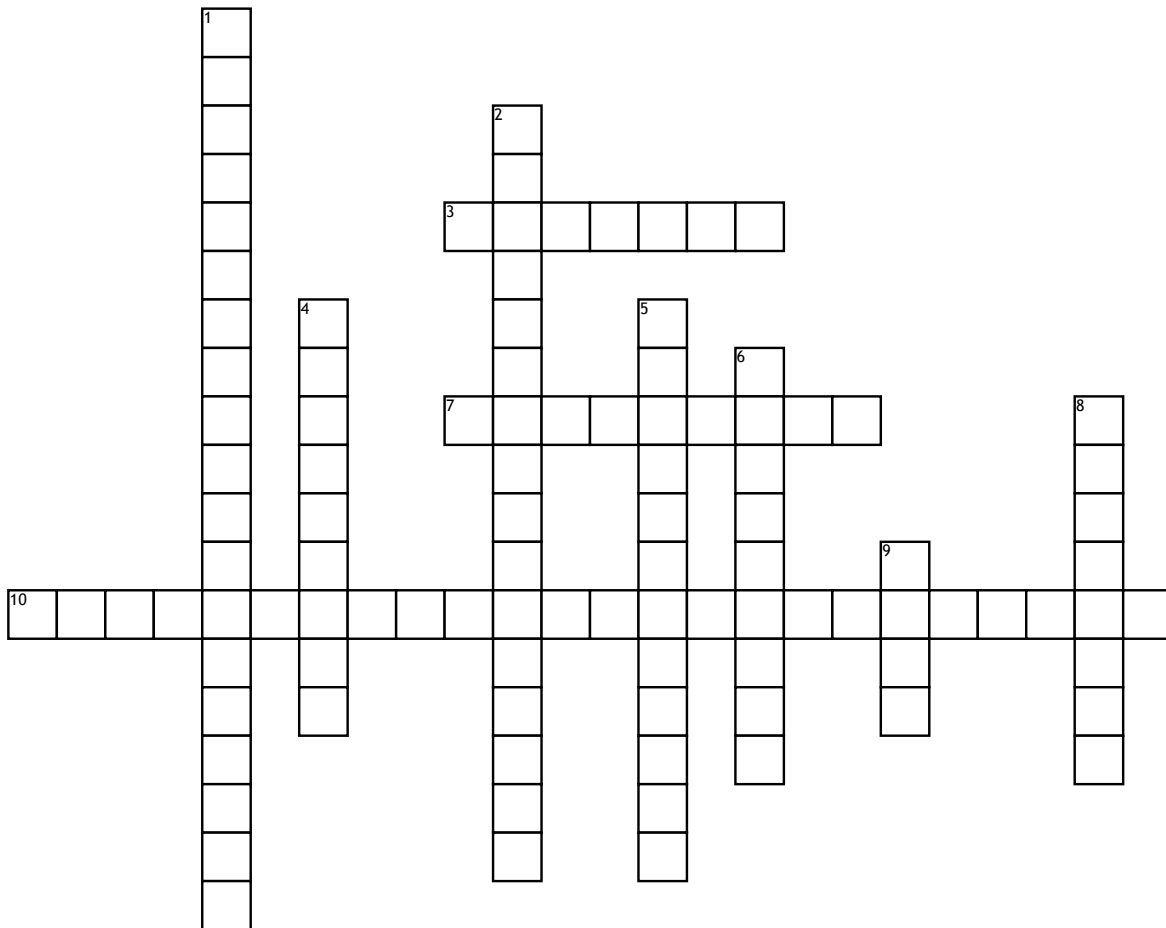


The Gilded Age Cross-Work Puzzle

- 5. the amount of goods and services created in a given period of time
