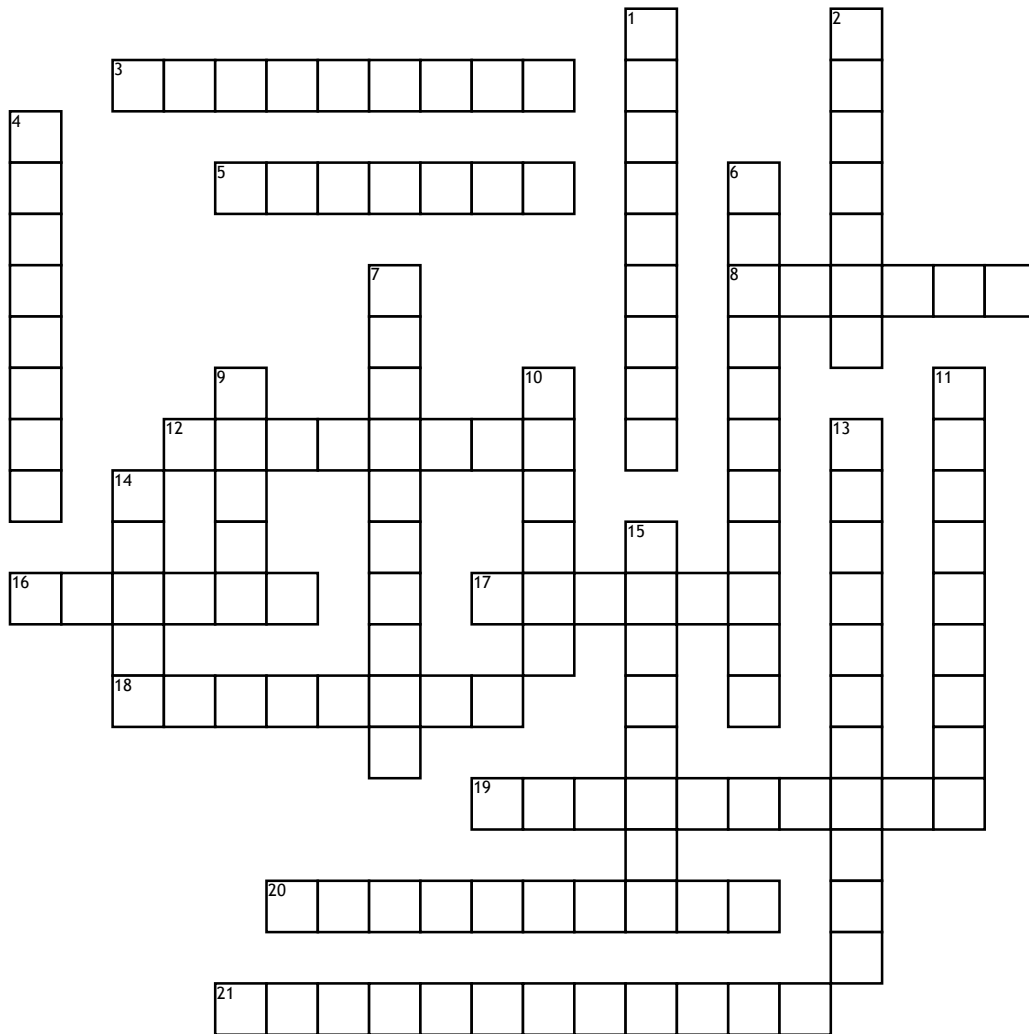


The Giver Crossword Puzzle
