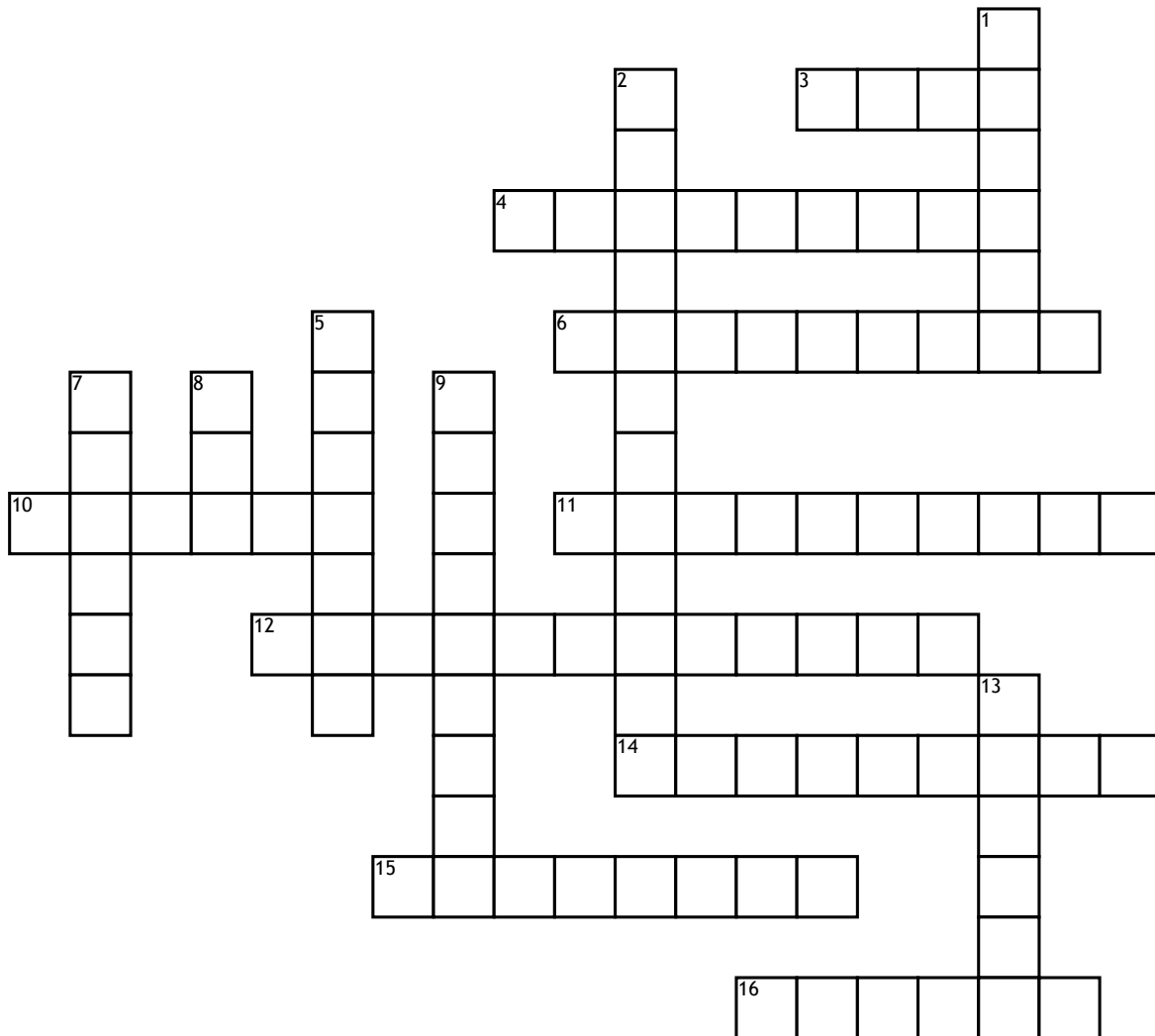


# The Glass castle crossword
