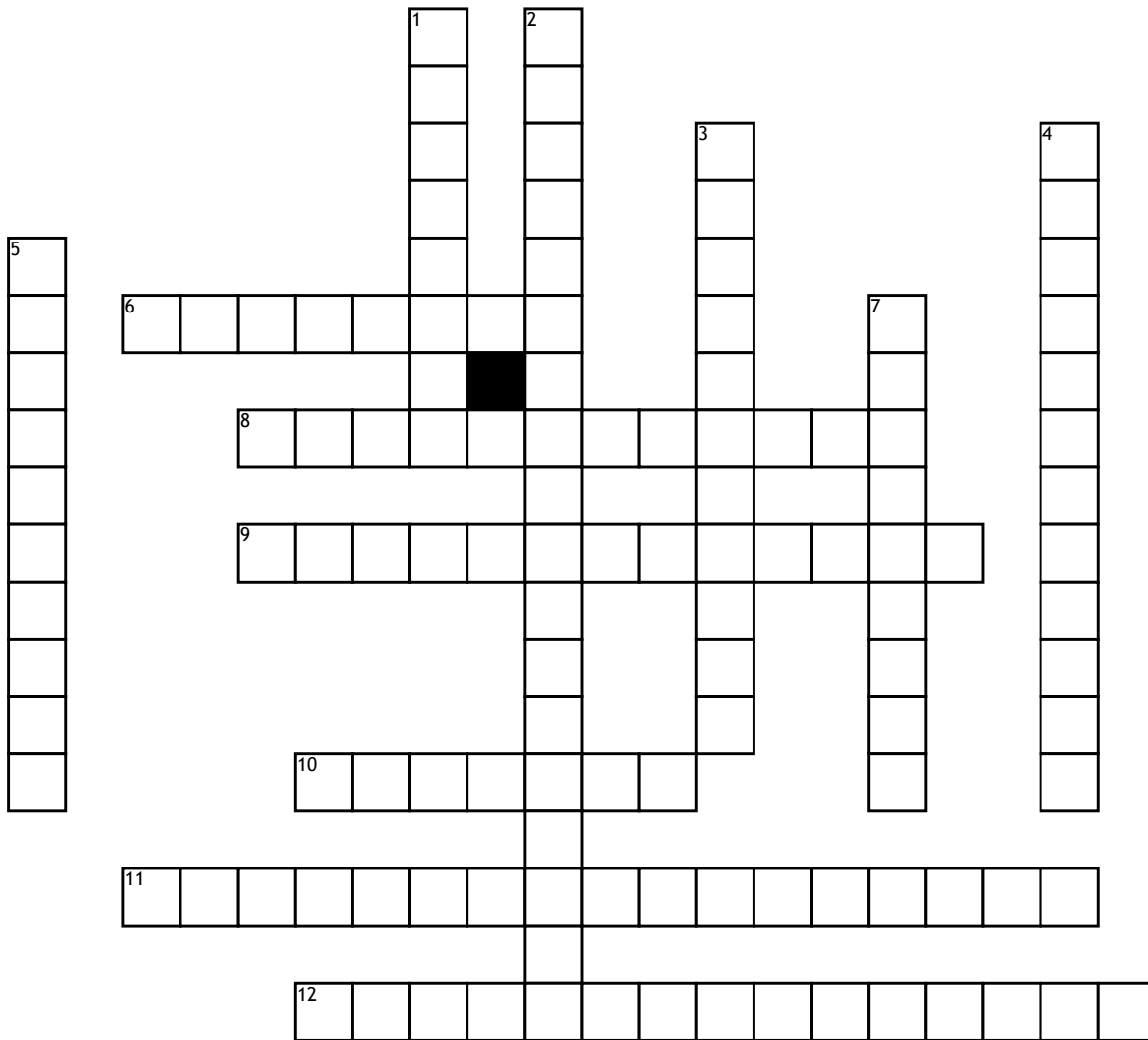


# The Great Depression
