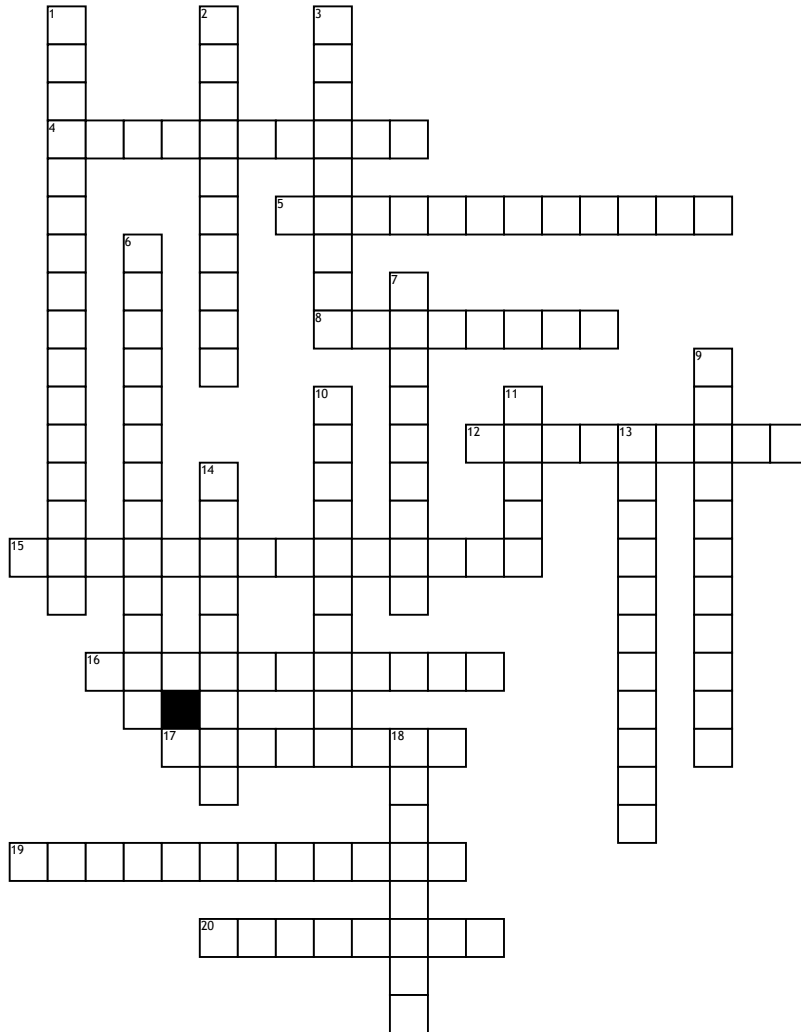


The Great Gatsby Vocab
