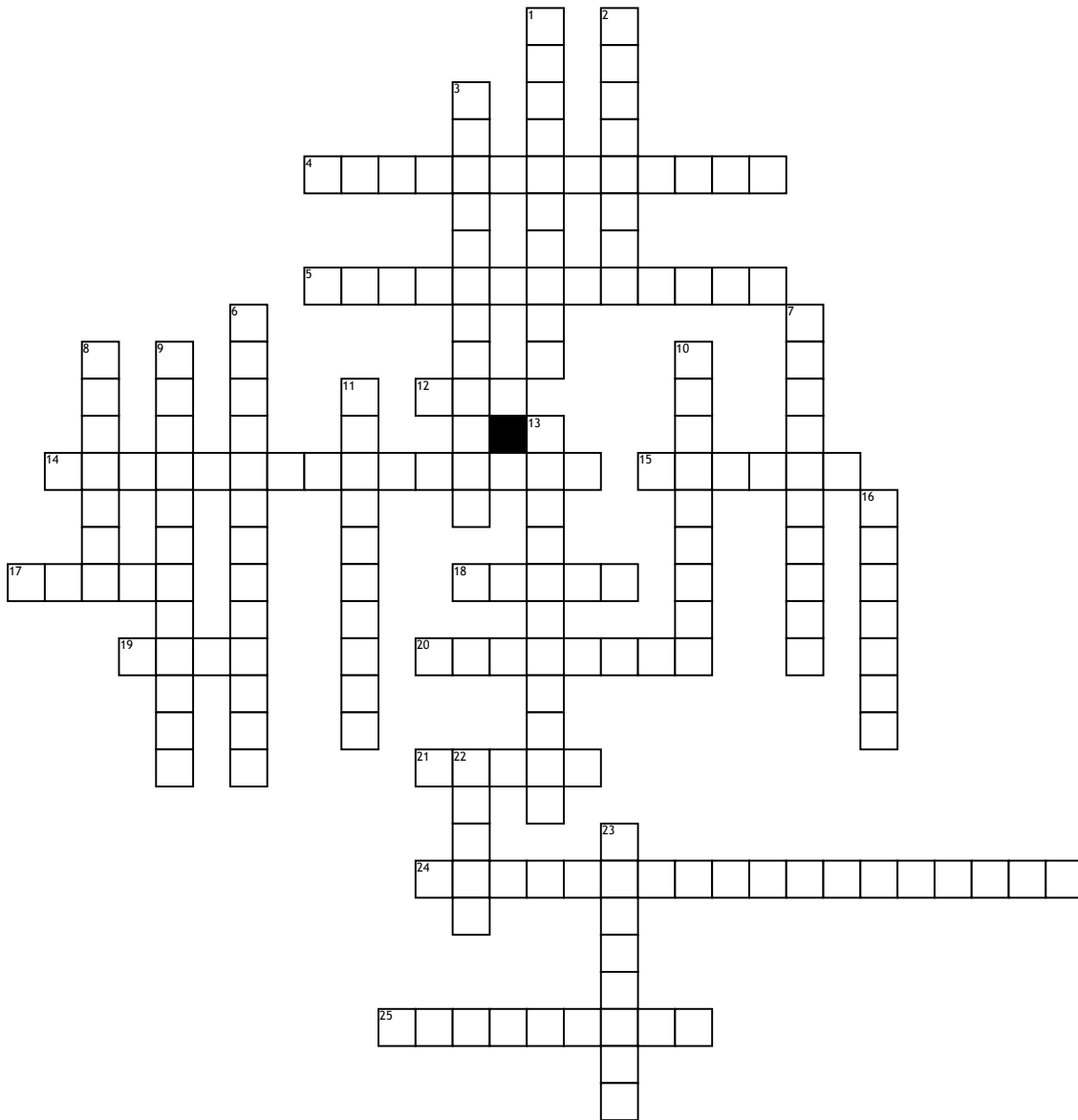


The Hot Zone Crossword Puzzle
