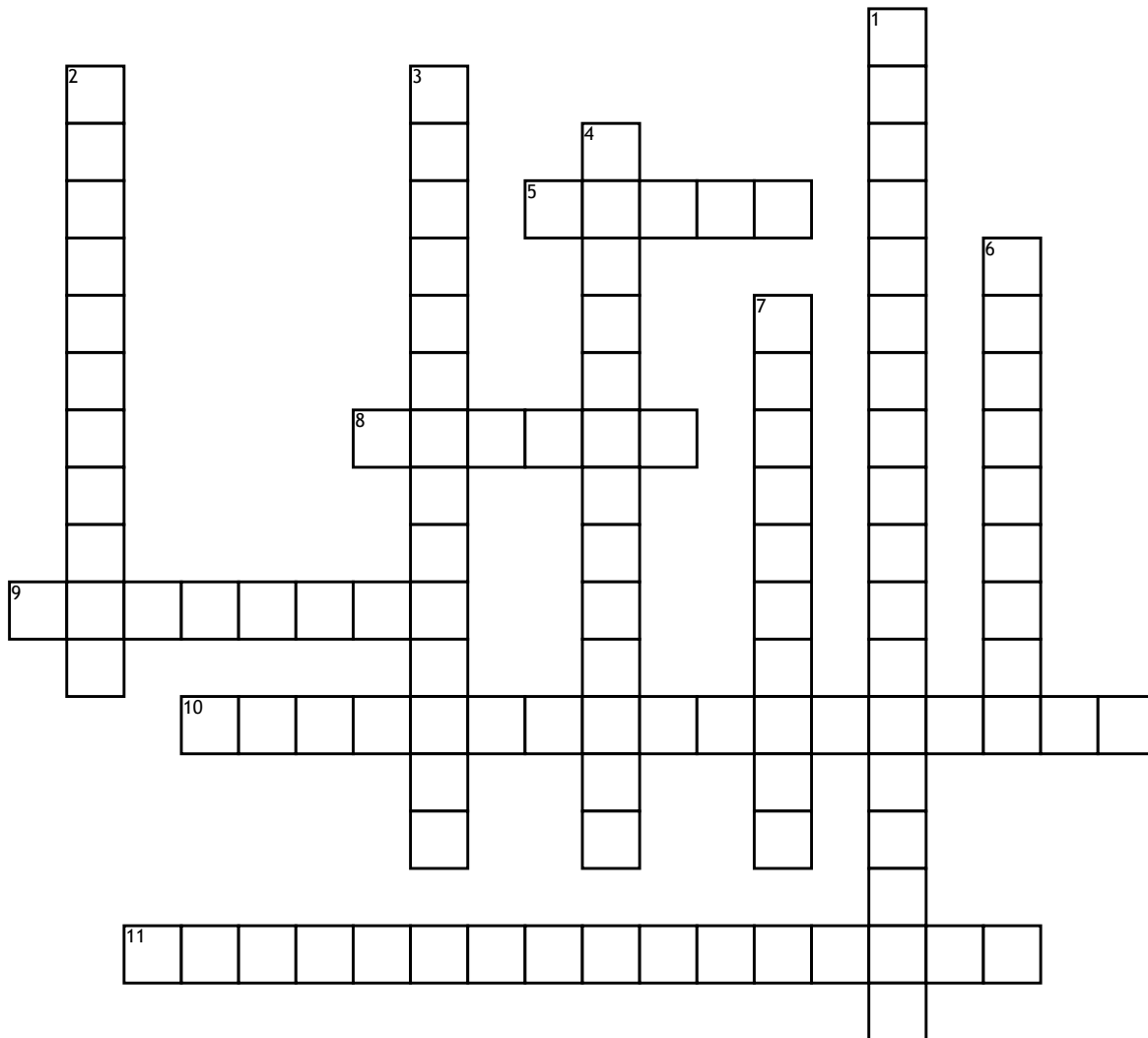


The Human Liver Crossword Puzzle.
