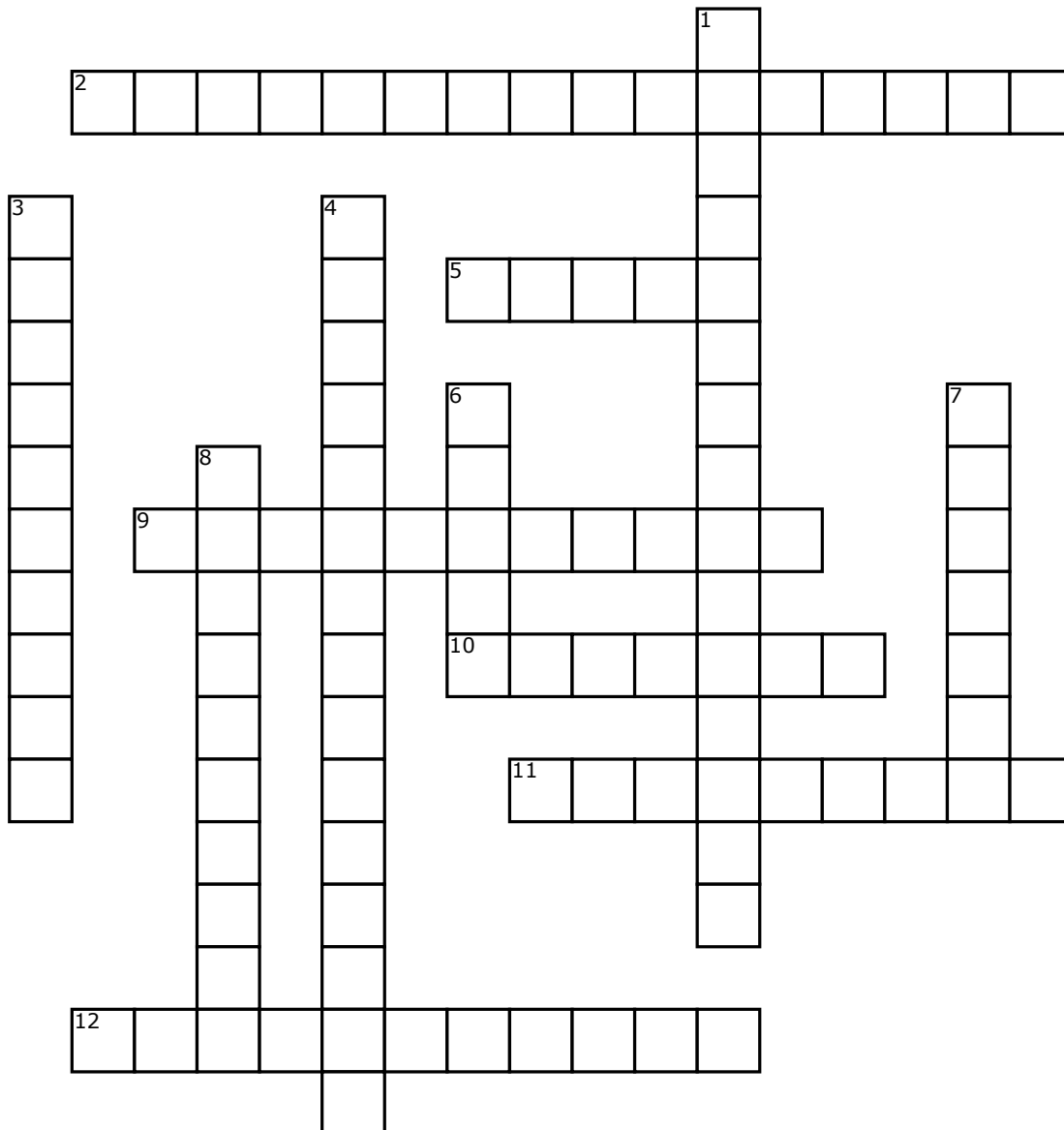


# The Infant
