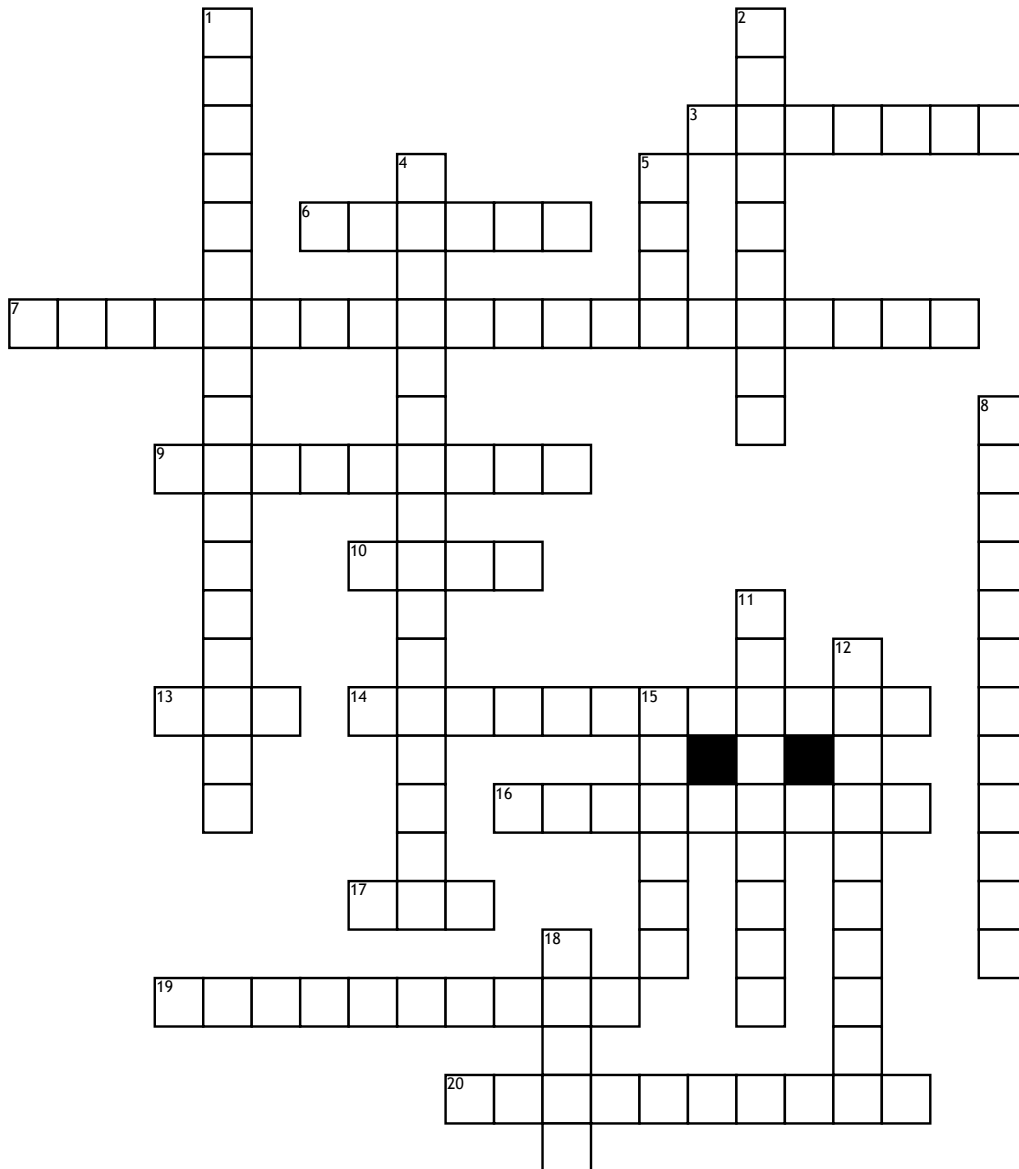


# The Korean War

- 3. Today Taiwan, was the seat of Chaing Kai-Shek's Chinese nationalist government-in-exile after it was defeated by Mao Zedong's communist forces
- 6. MacArthur's Marines, responsible for Inchon invasion
- 7. This is the circle of latitude that is 38 degrees above the equator, this line formed the line separating North and South Korea before the Korean War
- 9. Communist leader of North Korea from the Korean War til 1994
- 10. A river dividing North Korea and Manchuria
- 13. Republic of Korea

- 14. Place in North Korea bounded by Pyongyang, Chorwon, and Kumhwa, this was the communists staging attacks into South Korea
  - 16. An important industrial and agricultural center lying north of Korea
  - 17. (People's Republic of China) Communist China
  - 19. A country in East Asia that occupies the northern part of the peninsula of Korea
  - 20. A country in East Asia that occupies the southern part of the peninsula of Korea

- 1. Buffer zone between North and South Korea created under the armistice signed July 27, 1953 which ended the war, this zone was actually heavily militarized

- 2. North Korean capital
- 4. An American general who led the United Nation forces in the Korean War
- 5. (North Korean People's Army) the army of North Korea
- 8. Japanese army occupying Manchuria before and during World War II
- 11. The place where the last half of the peace-treaty negotiations during the Korean War (near 38th parallel)
- 12. This is where president Harry S Truman lived while the White House was being renovated, he met here with his key advisors to discuss the Korean War
- 15. On September 15, 1950, Douglas MacArthur made a landing here which allowed his X Corps to take Seoul and the rest of South Korea again
