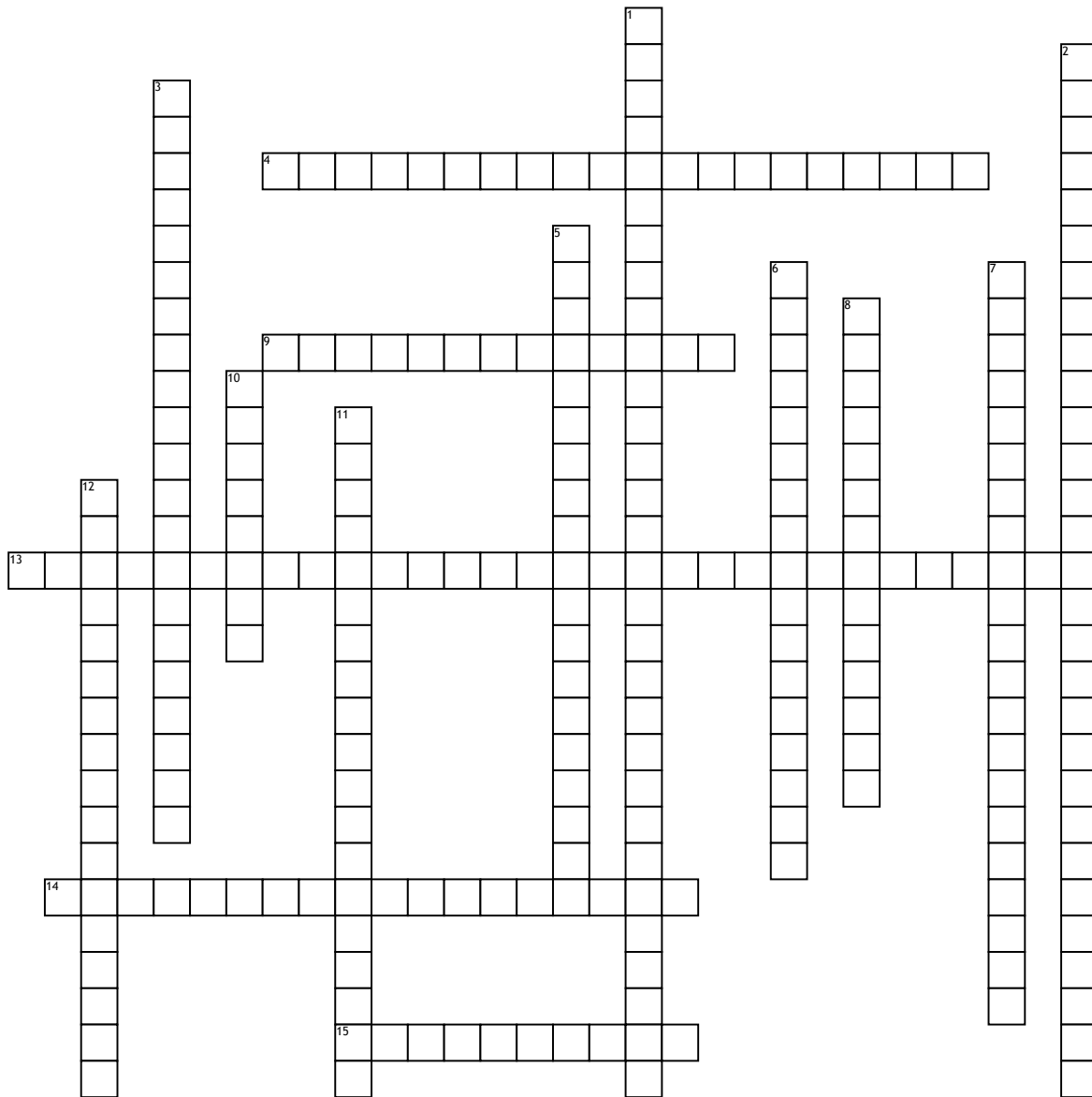


# The Language of Mortality
