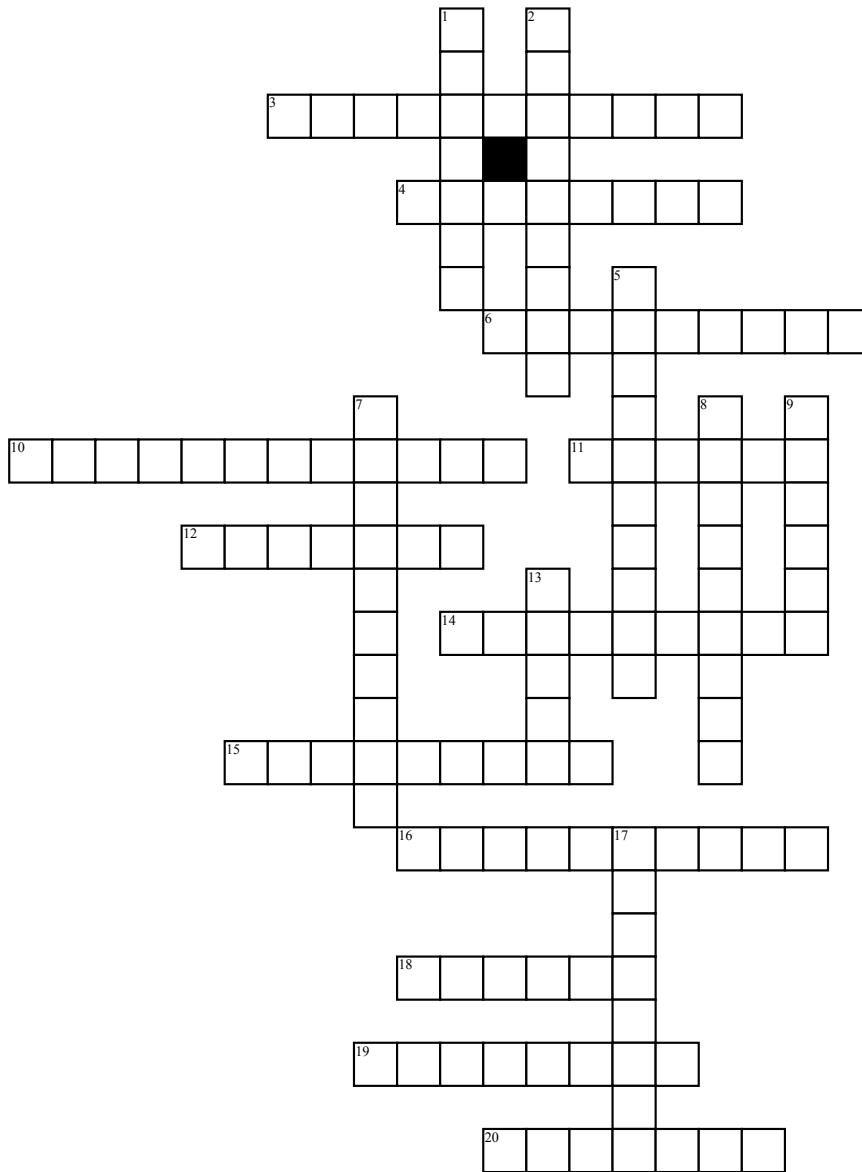


The Man from Snowy River
