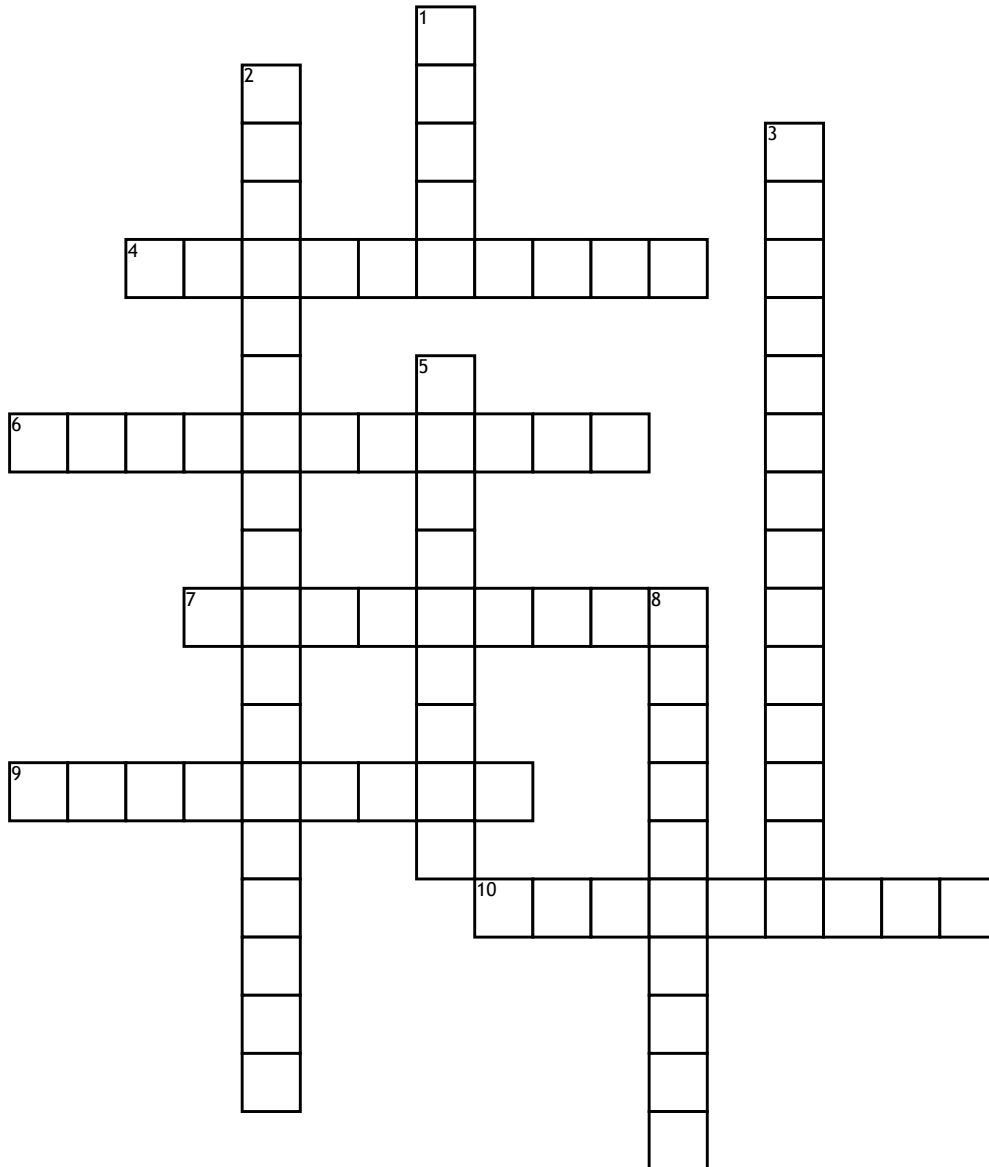

1. One of a group of disease-causing substances.
2. A microscope that uses beams of electrons instead of beams of light; of much higher power than an ordinary microscope
3. The ability to clearly distinguish between two objects

8. Disease-causing microorganisms intermediate in size between bacteria and viruses, carried in the tissue of arthropods (insects, etc.)>
