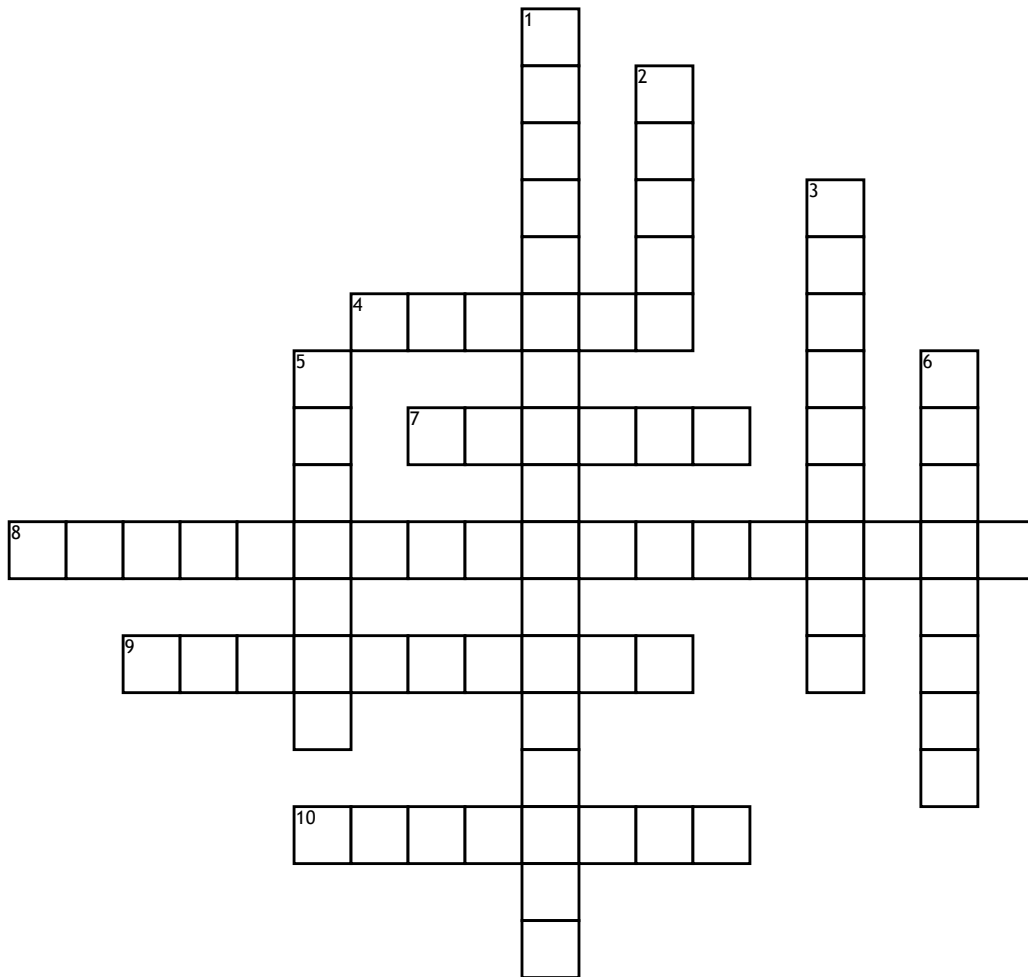


# The Nervous System
