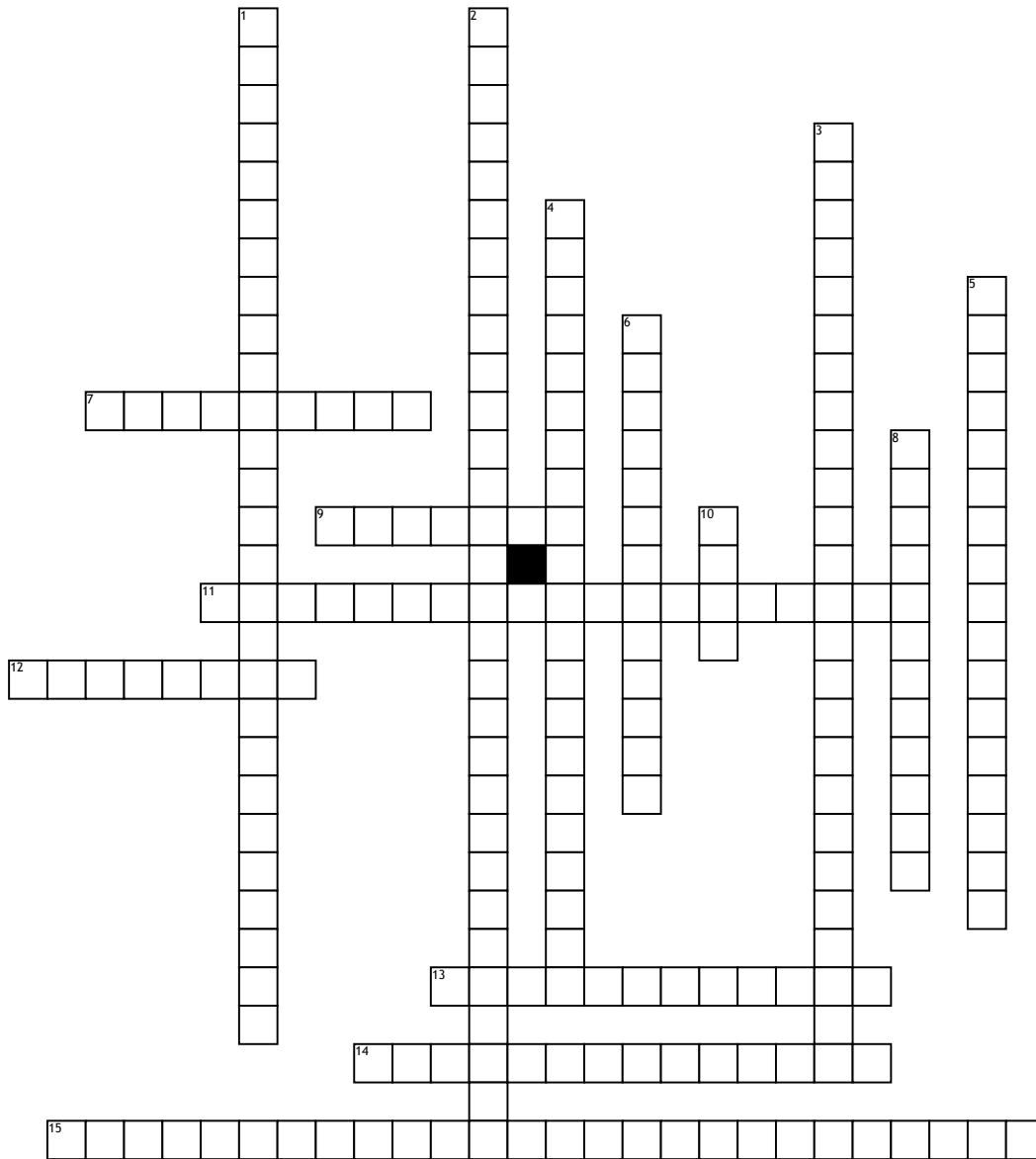


The New Deal

15. new deal program that gave jobs to unmarried men to maintain forests, beaches, and parks
