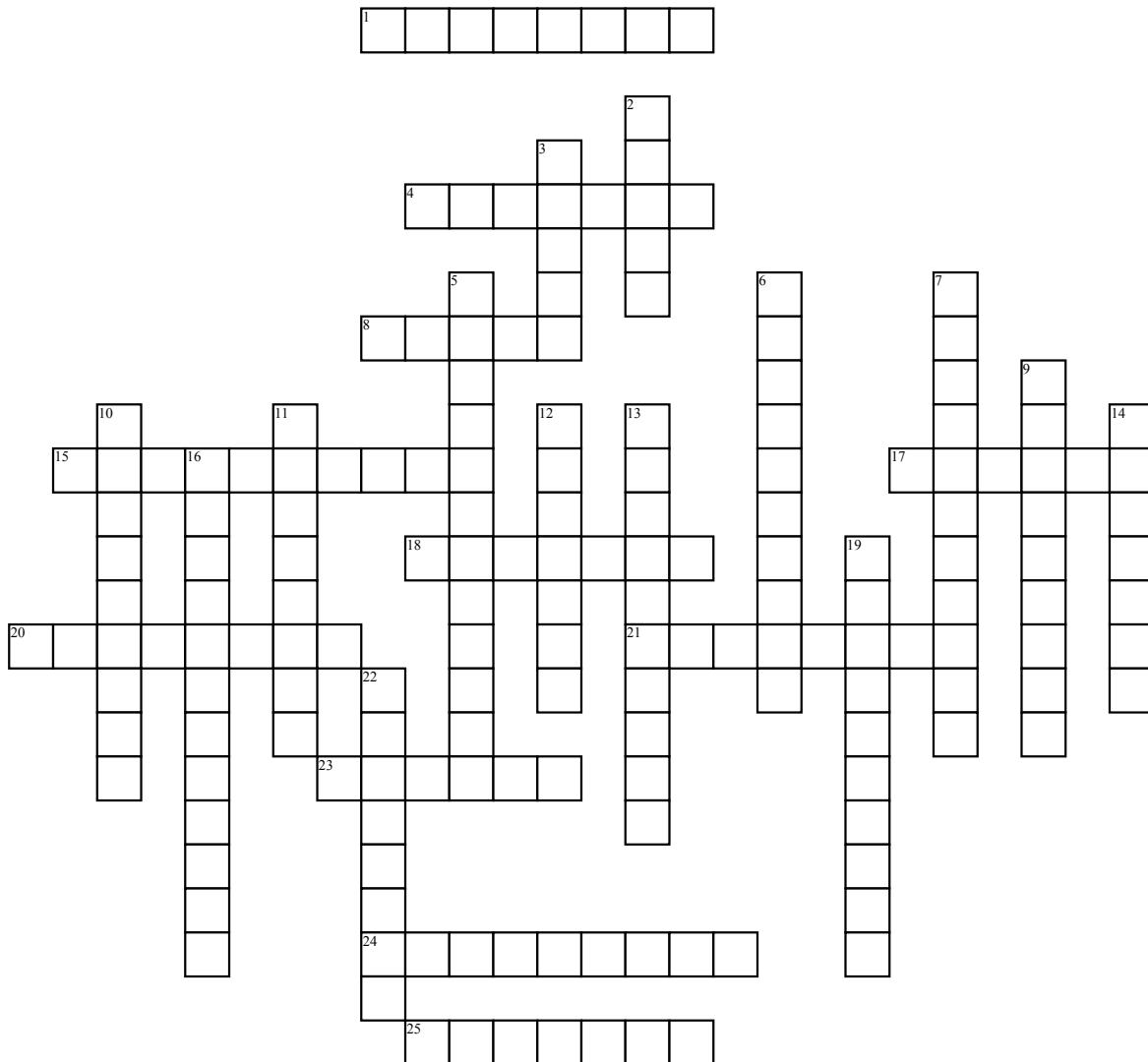


# The Outsiders
