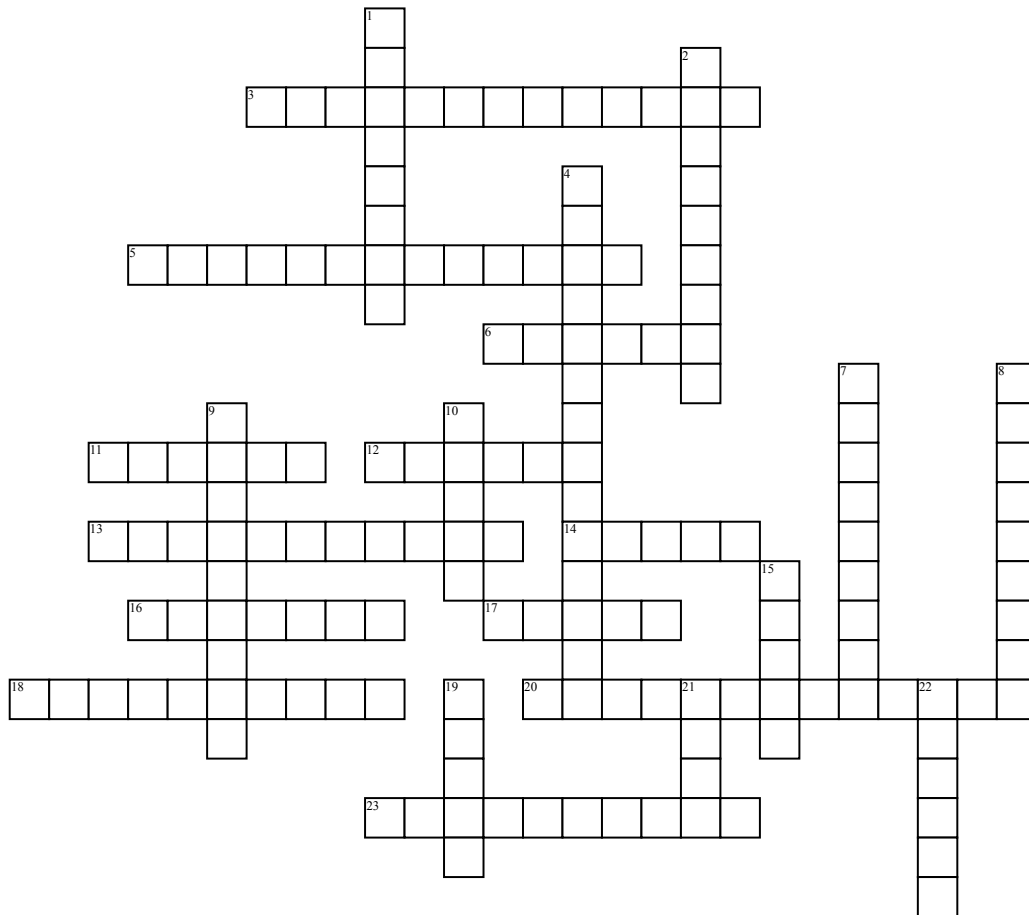


The Princess Bride Crossword Puzzle Activity
