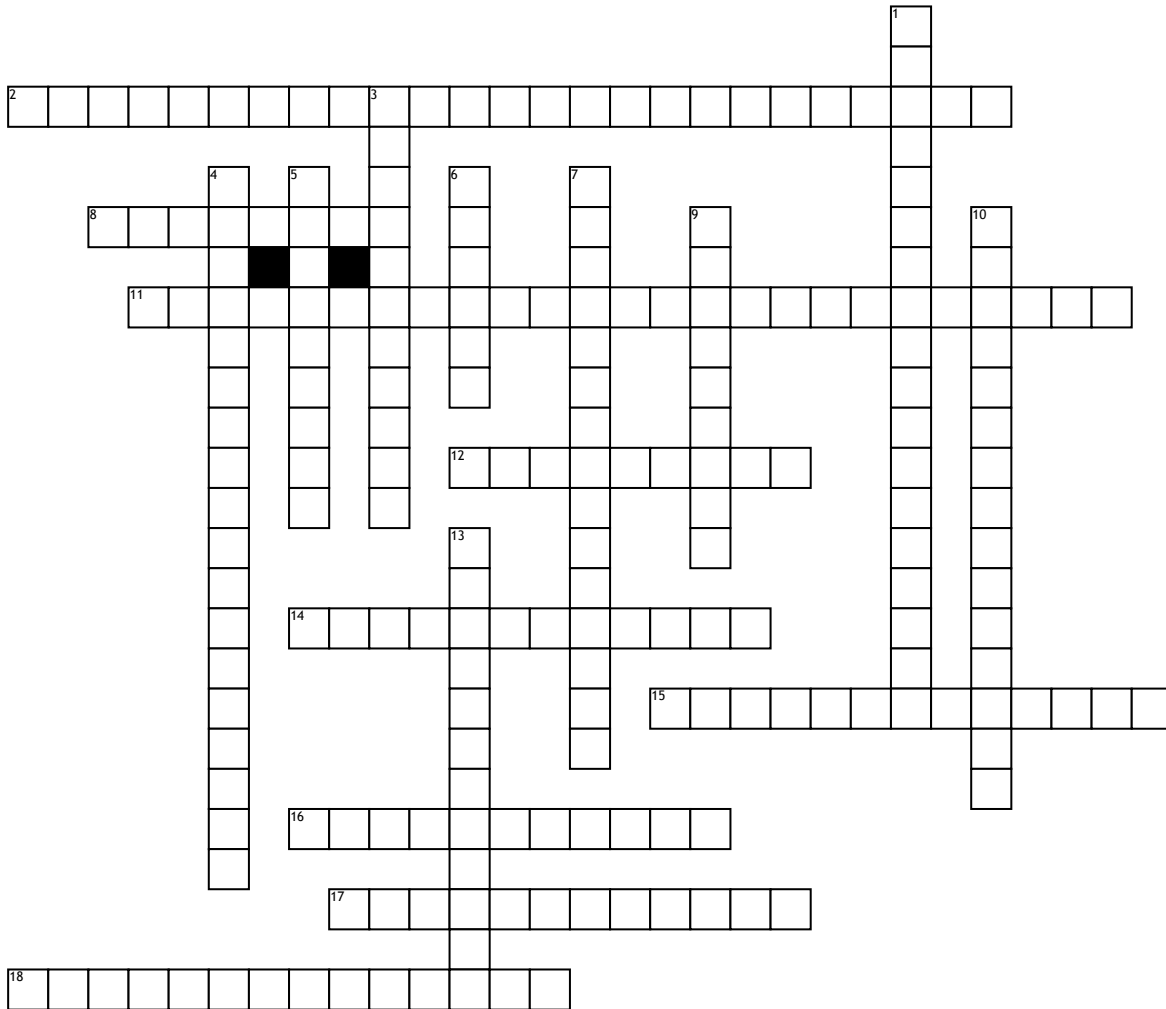


The Revolutionary War in Georgia

18. Chairman of the committee that drafted Georgia's first permanent constitution in 1777.

1. Called "The Seven Years War" in Europe.

3. In 1765, Britain passed this act that put a tax on paper goods that required colonists to buy government stamps for nearly all paper goods.

4. Many of the colonists felt cheated and were angry after this.

5. Tories were also called ----- because they were "loyal" to King George III.

6. Most citizens of Georgia were called this.

7. King George III was outraged at the citizens of Boston for the Boston Tea Party. In order to punish the colony of Massachusetts, a series of laws called the ----- were passed.

10. This "siege", on October 9, 1779, only lasted only 90 minutes.
