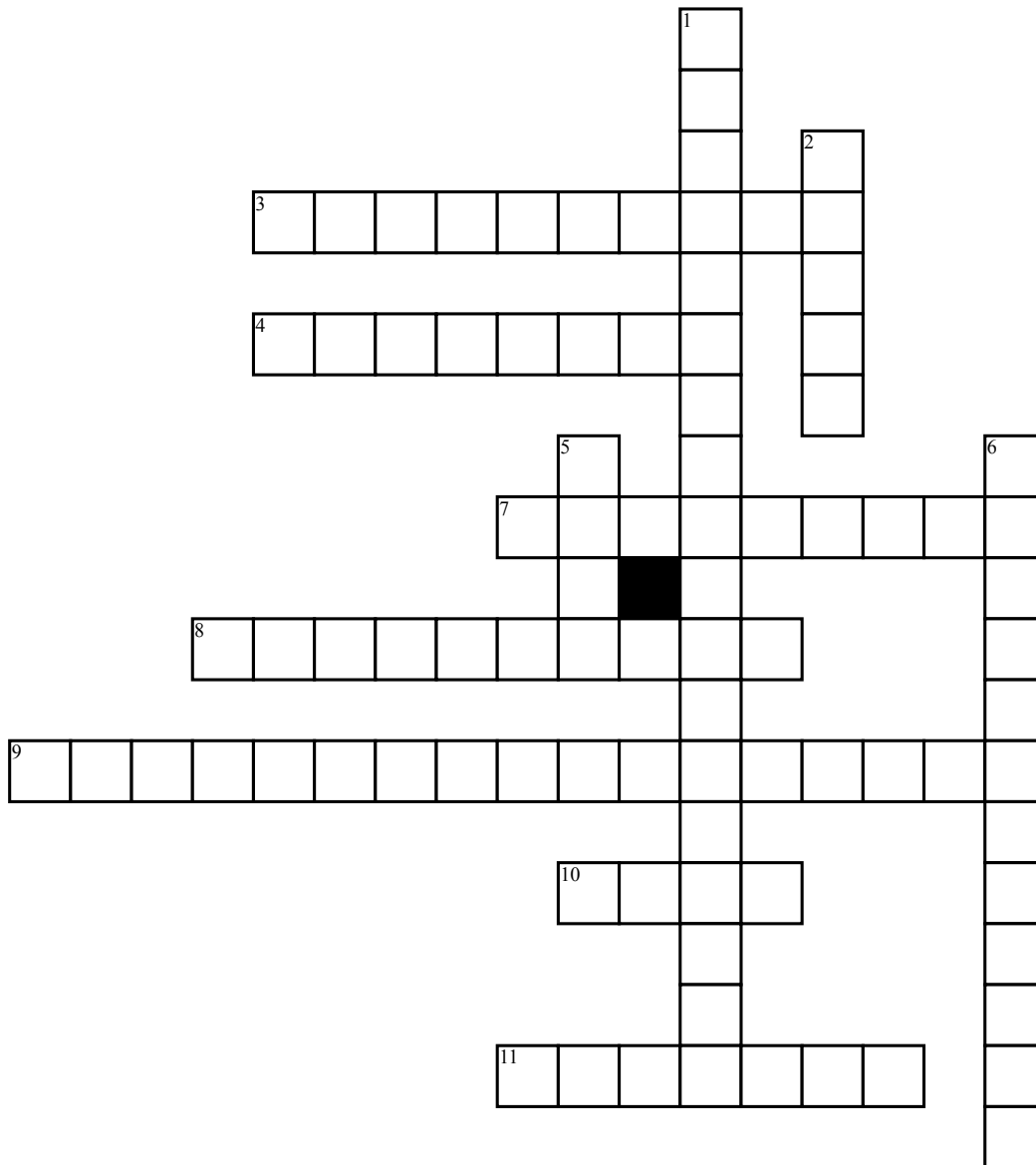


The Road To Timbuktu
