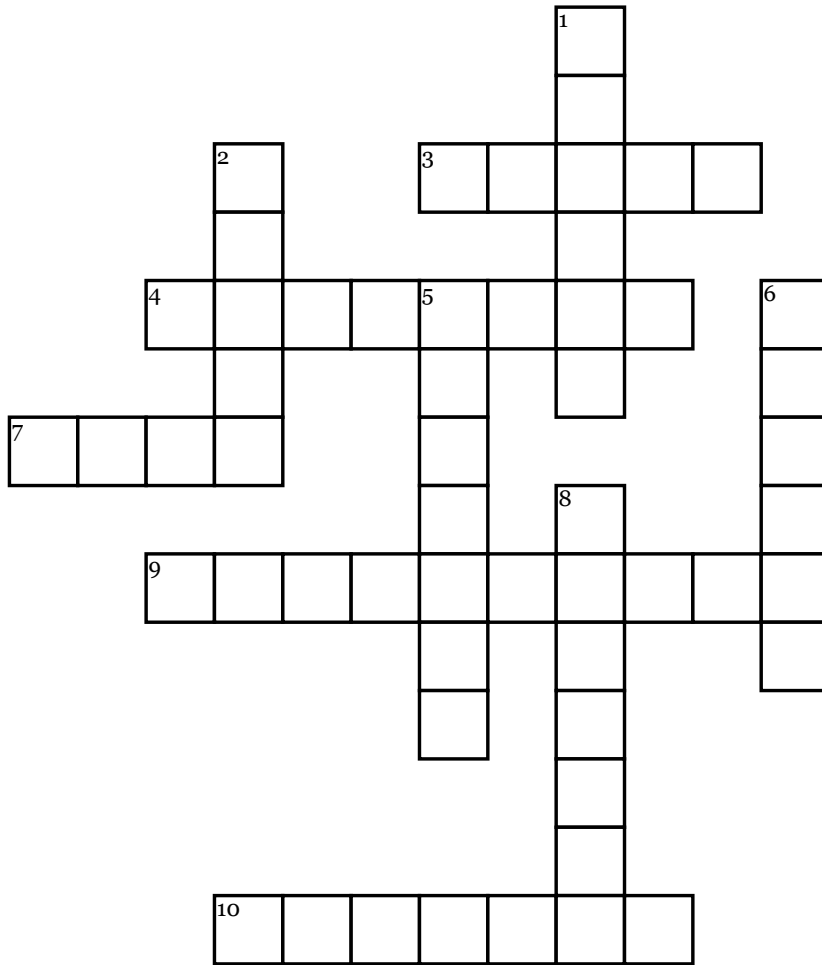


The Secret Life of Bees

- 6.** to pull or draw with force; move by drawing; drag
- 8.** to inhale through the lungs and expel it
