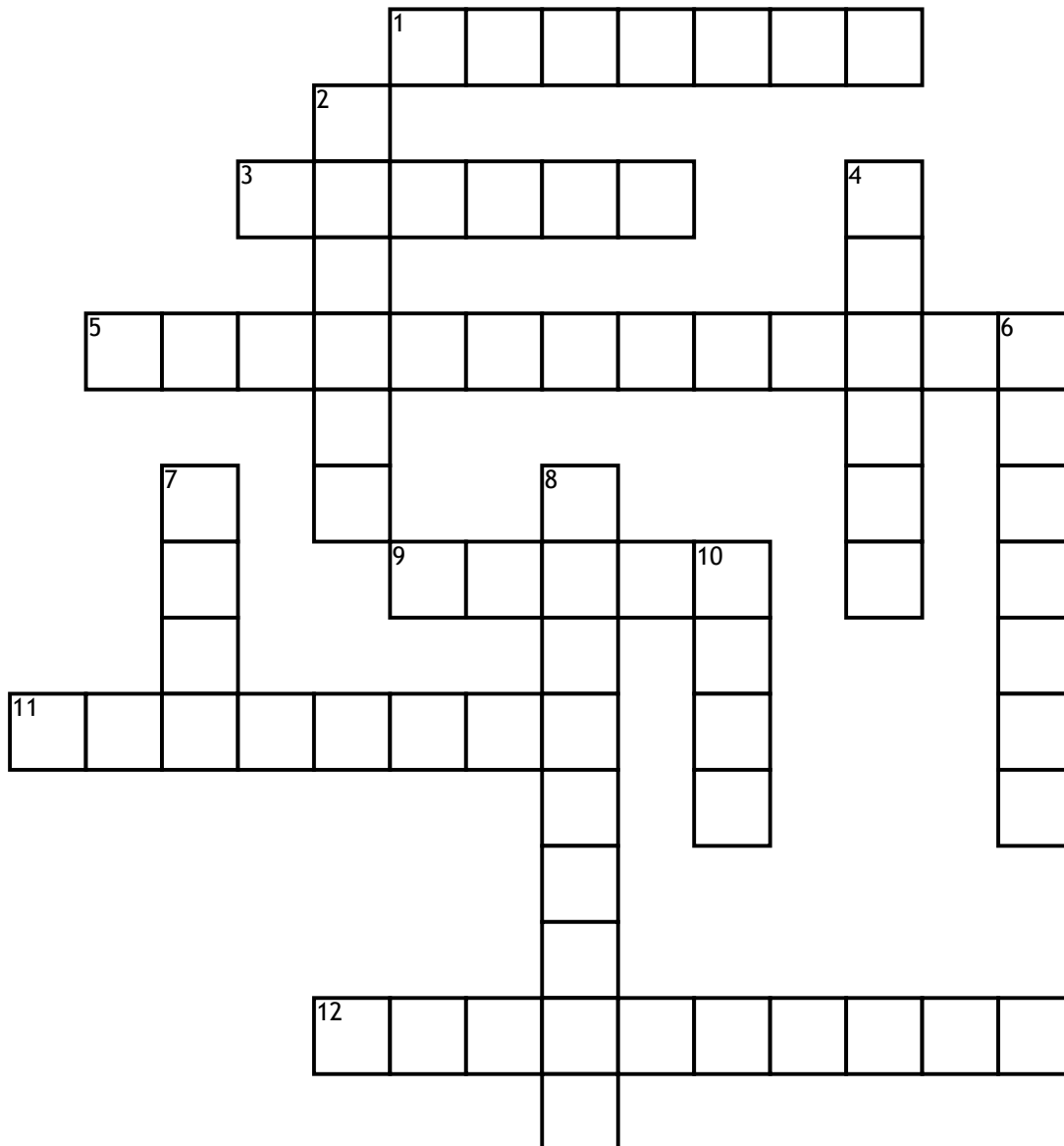


The Sense Organs

1. snail-shaped organ in the ear that receives sound waves

2. the layer of sensory neurons at the back of the eye that detects light
4. the clear, curved covering on the outer surface of the eye

6. the tightly stretched layer of tissue inside the ear that vibrates when hit with sound waves

7. the colored part of the eye that controls the size of the pupil

8. the outermost layer of skin
