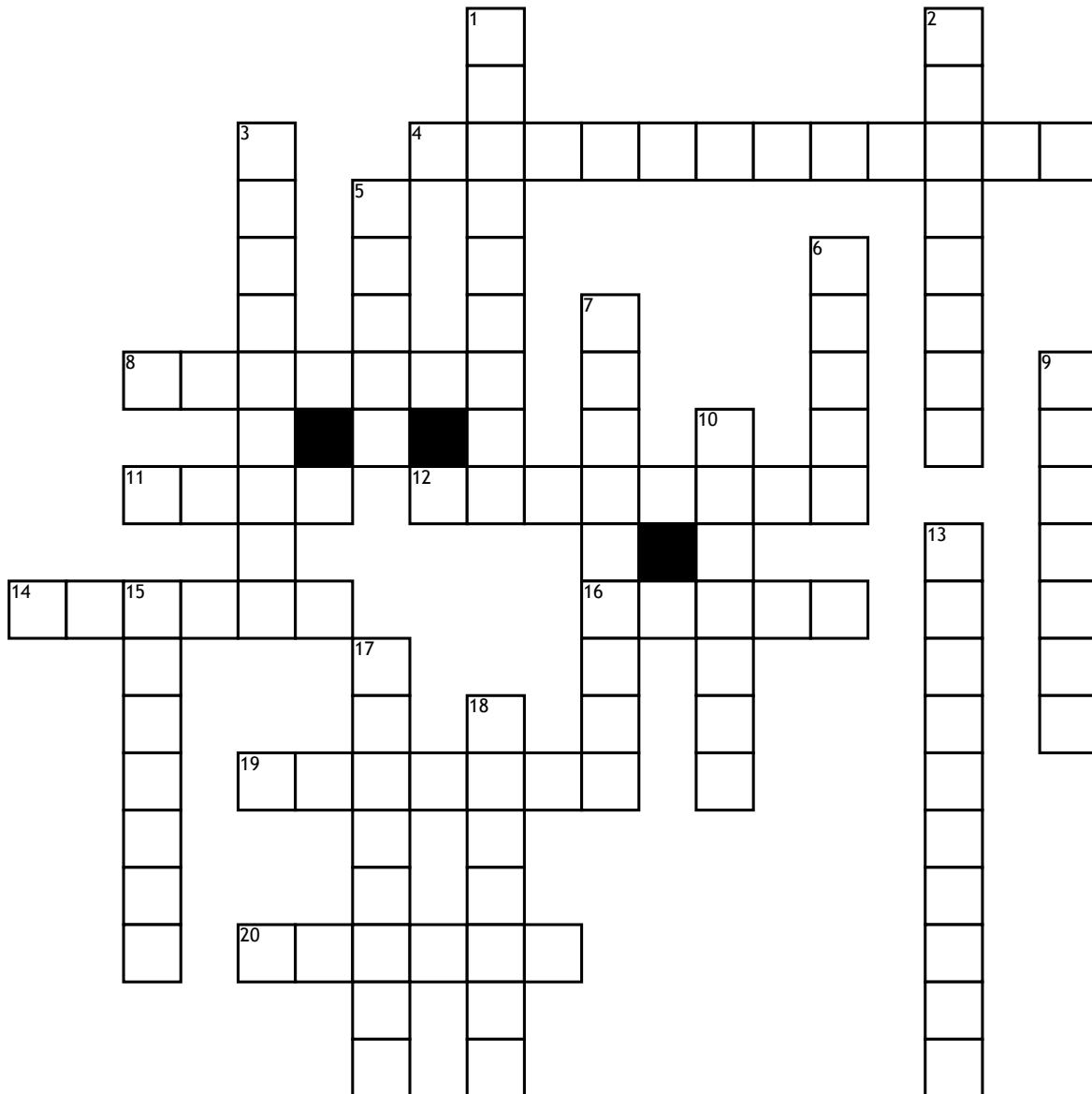


# The Territory of Nunavut
