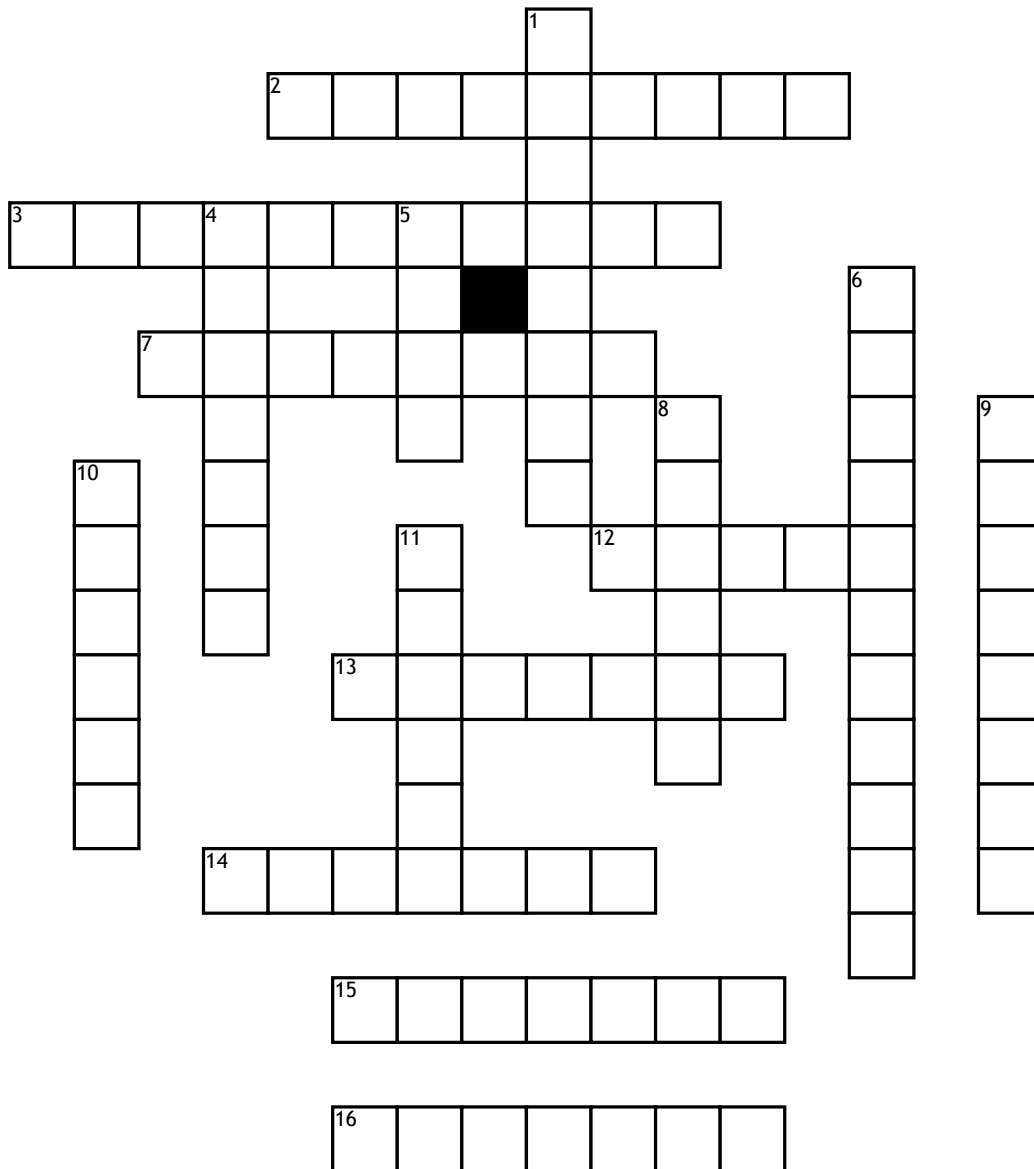


The Things They Carried
