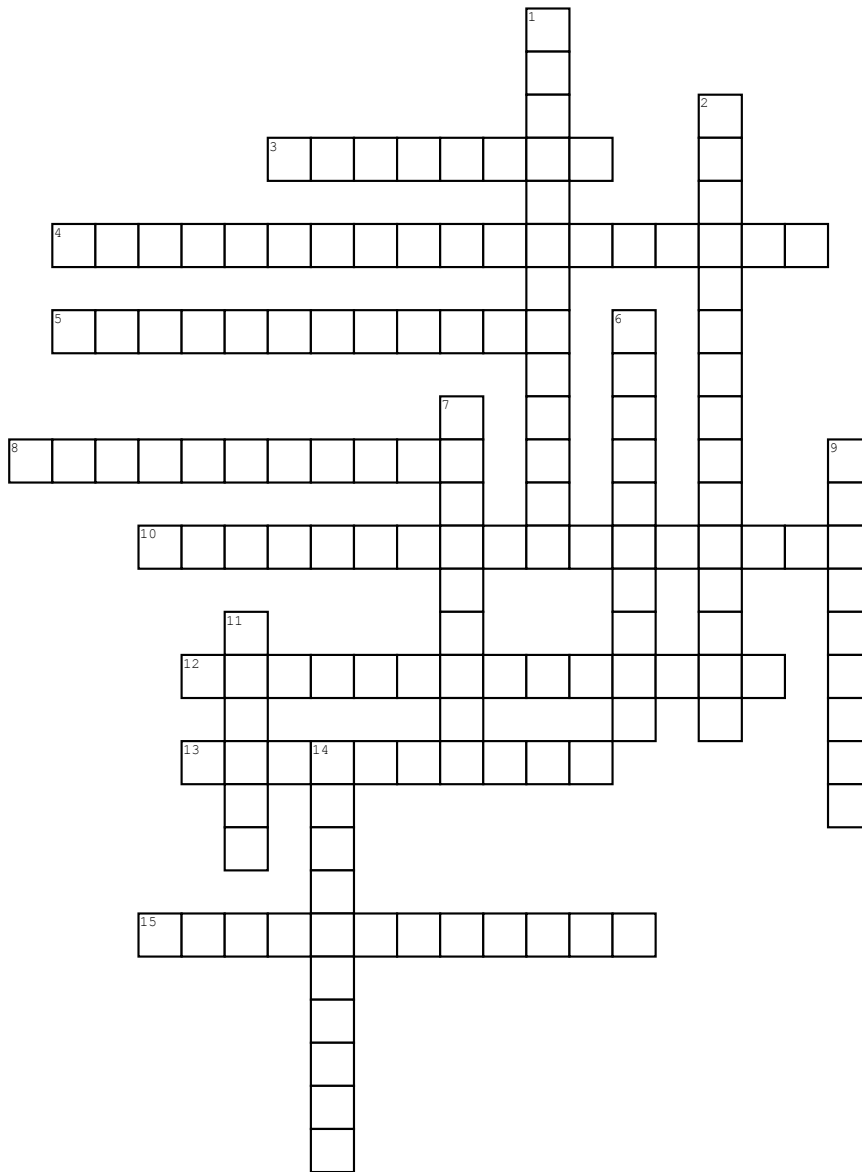


The Urinary System

3. producing too little urine
 4. inflammation of the kidney (primarily of the glomerulus)
 5. use of an artificial kidney machine that filters the blood of a person to remove waste products
 8. destroying or crushing stones in the bladder or urethra
 10. formation of multiple cysts within the kidney tissue, resulting in destruction of normal kidney tissue and uremia

12. inflammation of the renal pelvis and the kidney
 13. instrument to measure the specific gravity of urine
 15. downward displacement of the kidney out of its normal location

1. drug class used to prevent or reduce bladder muscle spasms
 2. urethra has become narrow
 6. drug class used to treat bacterial infections of the urinary tract

7. protrusion of the urinary bladder into the wall of the vagina
 9. surgical fixation of the urinary bladder, performed to correct a cystocele
 11. presence of pus in the urine
 14. to cut into the kidney
