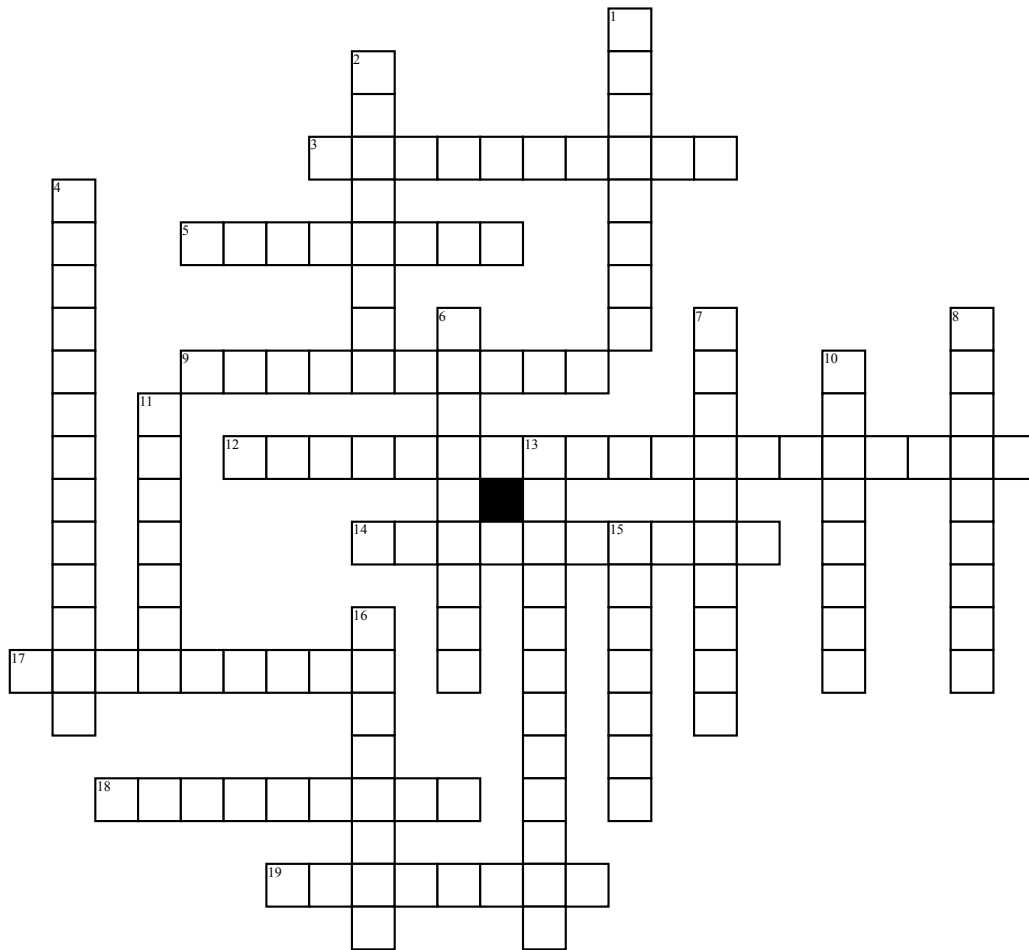


The Urinary System
